

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may acciue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien inposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lianer, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof-which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

b Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be illed -

(A) Under State Lews

(f) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Oi Deads Of The District Of Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lieft - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, at the residence of the texpayer at the time the notice of tien is filed.

For purpose 5 of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or particles thall be deemed to be the place at which the princlosi executive office of the business is located, and the rest dence of a true yet whose residence is without the United States shall be ceamed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The 'sim at 3 content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary, Such notice shall be valid notwil isterding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of hen.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be irested as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such retiling period.

(2) Place For Filing.—A notice of fien reflied during the required retiling period shall be effective only

(A) if-

(i) such notice of lien is relifed in the office in which the prior notice of then was filled, and

(ii) In the case of real property, the lact of reflling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such light state ed in liberature with exception (f) in the State of in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of lian, the term "required reflling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax; and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the class of the preceding required retiting period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payme the propert assessed, together with all interest in respect there it, with a the time prescribed by law (including any autension of surf. final, and that is in accordance with such requirements relating it terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(x) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien.-If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
