WHEREAS, Borrower has entered into a Promissory Note and Line of Credit Agreement	(the "Note") dated

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6. Protection of Lander's Security. If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that materially affects Lender's interest in the Property, including, but not limited to, any proceeding by or on behalf of a prior mortgagee, eminent domain, insolvency, code enforcement, or arrangements or proceedings involving a bankrupt or decedent, then Lender, at Lender's option, upon notice to Borrower, may make such appearances, disbutse such sums and take such action as is necessary to protect Lender's interest, including, but not limited to, disbursement of reasonable attorney's fees and entry upon the Property to make repairs.

Any amounts disbursed by Lender pursuant to this paragraph 6, with interest thereon, shall become additional indebtedness of Borrower secured by this Mortgage. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, such amounts shall be payable upon Lender's demand and shall bear interest from time to time on outstanding principal under the Agreement. Nothing contained in this paragraph 6 shall require Lender to incur any expense or take any action hereunder.

- 7. Inspection. Lender may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property, provided that Lender shall give Borrower notice prior to any such inspection specifying reasonable cause therefore related to Lender's interest in the Property.
- 8. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of the Property, or part thereof, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender. In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage, with the excess, if any, poid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property, that fraction of the proceeds of the award with a numerator equal to control of Loans and other amounts secured immediately before the taking, and a denominator equal to the value of the Property immediately before the taking, shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage, and the excess paid to the Borrower.

If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or, if, after notice by Lender to Borrower that the condemnor has offered to make an award or settle a claim for Camages. Borrower fails to respond to Lender within 30 days after the date such notice is mailed, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the proceeds, at Lender's option, either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Mortgage.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any such application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the amount due under the Agreement or change the amount of such payments.

- 9. Burrower Not Released. No extension of the time, for payment or modification of any other term of the Agreement or this Mortgage granted by Lender to any successor in interest of the Corrower shall operate to release, in any manner, the liability of the original Borrower's successors in interest. Lend v shall not be required to commence proceedings against such successor or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify by r ason of any demand made by the original Borrower and Borrower's successors in interest.
- 10. Forbearance by Lender Not a Waiver. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy under the Agreement hereunder, or otherwise afforded by applicable law, shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any such right or remedy. The procurement of insurance or the payment of taxes or other liens or charges by Lender shall not be a waiver of Lender's right to accelerate the maturity of the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.
- II. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Captions. The coverants and agreements herein contained shall bind, and the rights hereunder shall inure to the respective successors and assigns of Lende, and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 16 hereof. All covenants and agreements of Borrower shall be joint and several. The captions and headings of the paragraphs of this Mortgage are for convenience only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions hereof.
- 12. Legislation Affecting Lender's Rights, if enactment or expiration of applicable laws has the effect of rendering any provision of the Agreement or this Mortgage unenforceable according to its terms, Lender, at its option, may red the immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Mortgage and may invoke any remedies permitted by paragraph 18.
- 13. Notice. Except for any notice required under applicable law to be given in another manner, (a) any notice to Borrower provided for in this Mortgage shall be given by mailing such notice by certified mail addressed to Borrower at the Property Address or at such other address as Borrower may designate by notice to Lender as provided herein, and (b) any notice to Lender shall be given by certified mail, return receipt requested, to Lender's address stated herein or to such other address as Lender may designate by notice to Borrower as provided herein. Any notice provided for in this Mortgage shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given in the manner designated herein.
- 14. Governing Law; Severability. This Mortgage shall be governed by the laws of Illinois. In the event that any provision or clause of this Mortgage or the Note conflicts with applicable laws, such conflict shall of the Mortgage and the Note are declared to be severable; provided that the Lender may exercise its termination option provided in paragraph 12 in the event of changes in law after the date of this Mortgage.
- 15. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be furnished a conformed copy of the Note and of this Mortgage at the time of execution or after recordation hereof.
- 16. Transfer of the Property; Assumption. To the extent permitted by law, if all or any part of the Property or an interest therein, including without limitation any part of any beneficial interest in the Property in any trust holding title to the Property, is sold or transferred by Borrower without Lender's prior written consent. Lender may, at Lender's option, declare all the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable.
- 17. Revolving Credit Loan. This Mortgage is given to secure a revolving credit loan and shall secure not only presently existing indebtedness under the Agreement but also future advances, whether such advances are obligatory or to be made at the option of the Lender, or otherwise, as are made within 5 years from the date hereof, to the same extent as if such future advances were made on the date of the execution of this Mortgage, although there may be no advance made at the time of execution of this Mortgage and

BORROWER COVENANTS the Borrower is lawfully seized of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant, and convey the Property, and that Borrower will warrant and defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any mortgages, declarations, easements, or restrictions listed in a schedule of exceptions to coverage in any title insurance policy insuring Bank's interest in the Property.

COVENANTS. Borrower covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. Payment of Principal and Interest. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the indebtedness incurred pursuant to the Note, together with any fees and charges provided in the Note.
- 2. Application of Payments. Unless applicable law provides otherwise, all payments received by Lender under the Note and paragraph I hereof shall be applied by Lender first in payment of amounts payable to Lender by Borrower under this Mortgage, then to interest, fees, and charges payable pursuant to the Agreement, then to the principal amounts outstanding under the Agreement.
- 3. Charges; Liens. Borrower shall pay or cause to be paid all taxes assessments, and other charges, fines, and impositions attributable to the Property that may attain a priority over this Mortgage, leasehold payments or ground rents, if any, and all payments due under any nortgage disclosed by the title insurance policy insuring the Lender's interest in the Property (the "First Mortgage"), if any. Upon Lender's request, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing payments of amounts due under this paragraph. Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien that has priority over this Mortgage, except the lien of the First Mortgage; provided, that Dorrower shall not be required to discharge any such lien so long as Borrower shall agree in writing to the payment of the obligation sective, by such lien in a manner acceptable to Lender, or shall in good faith contest such lien by, or defend enforcement of such lien in, legal proceedings that operate to prevent the enforcement of the lien or forfeiture of the Property or any part thereof.
- 4. Hazard Insurance. Borrower she'le keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage", and such other hazards as Lender may require and in such amounts and for such periods as Lender may equire; provided, that Lender shall not require that the amount of such coverage exceed that amount of coverage required to pay the to al amount secured by this Mortgage, taking prior liens and co-insurance into account.

The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower and approved by the Lender (which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld). All premiums on insurance policies shall be paid in a timely manner. All insurance policies and renewals thereof shall be in form acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause in favor of and in form acceptable to Lender. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all re iev al notices and all receipts for paid premiums. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Lender. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged, provided such restoration or repair is economically feasible and the security of this Mortgage is not thereby impaired. If such restoration or repair is not economically feasible or if the security of this Mortgage would be impaired, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage, with the excess, if in; paid to Borrower. If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or if Borrower fails to respond to Lender within 30 days from the uatr notice is mailed by Lender to Borrower that the insurance carrier offers to settle a claim for insurance benefits, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the insurance proceeds at Lender's option either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Mortgage.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any such application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the payments due under the Agreement or change the amount of such payments. If under paragraph 19 hereof, the Property is acquired by Bank, all right, title, and interest of Borrower in and to any insurance policies and in and to the the proceeds thereof resulting from damage to the Property prior to the sale or acquisition shall pass to be four to the extent of the sums secured by this Mortgage immediately prior to such sale or acquisition.

5. Preservation and Maintenance of Property; Leaseholds; Condominiums; Planned Unit Developments, Borrower shall keep the Property in good repair and shall not commit waste or permit impairment or deterioration of the Property and shall comply with the provisions of any lease if this Mortgage is on a leasehold. If this Mortgage is on a unit in a condominium or a planned unit development, Borrower shall perform all of Borrower's obligations under the declaration or covenants creating or governing the condominium or planned unit development, the bylaws and regulations of the condominium or planned unit development, and constituent documents. If a condominium or planned unit development rider is executed by Borrower and recorded together with this Mortgage, the covenants and agreements of such rider shall be incorporated into and shall amend and supplement the covenants and agreements of this Mortgage as if the rider were a part hereof.

Acceleration; Remedies, Upon Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement of Borrower in this Mortgage, including the covenants to pay when due any sums secured by this Mortgage, or the occurrence of an Event of Default under the Agreement, which Events of Default are incorporated herein by this reference as though set forth in full herein, Lender at Lender's option, may declare all of the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable without further demand, may terminate the availability of loans under the Agreement, and may foreclose this Mortgage by judicial proceeding. Lender shall be entitled to collect in such proceeding all expenses of foreclosure, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees, and costs of documentary evidence, abstracts, and title reports.

All remedies provided in this Mortgage are distinct and cumulative to any other right or remedy under this Mortgage, the Agreement, or afforded by law or equity, and may be exercised concurrently, independently, or successively.

19. Assignment of Rents; Appointment of Receiver; Londer in Possession. As additional security hereunder, Bortower hereby assigns to Lender the rents of the Property, provided that Bortower shall, prior to acceleration under paragraph 18 hereof or abandonment of the Property, have the right to collect and retain such tents as they become due and payable.

Upon acceleration under paragraph 18 hereof or abandonment of the Property, and at any time prior to the expiration of any period of redemption follo ving judicial sale, Lender, in person, by agent, or by judicially appointed receiver, shall be entitled to enter upon, take possession of and manage the Property and to collect the rents of the Property including those past due. All rents collected by Lender or the receiver single applied first to payment of the costs of management of the Property and collection of rents including, but not limited to receiver's less, premiums on receiver's bonds and reasonable attorney's fees, and then to the sums secured by this Mortgage. Lender and the property shall be liable to account only for those rents actually received.

- 20. Release. Upon payment in full of all a mounts secured by this Mortgage and termination of the Agreement, Lender shall release this Mortgage without charge to Borrower. Ander shall pay all costs of recordation of the release, if any.
 - 21. Walver of Homestead, Borrower hereby wai es all right of homestead exemption in the Property.
- 22. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Section 18 of this Mortgage or in the Note, the Lender shall notify the Borrower at least 30 days prior to instituting any action leading to repossession or foreclosure (except in the case of the Borrower's abandonment of the Property or other extreme circumstances).
- 23. This Mortgage shall secure any and all renewals, extensions or modifications of the whole or any part of the indebtedness hereby secured however evidenced, with interest at such lawful rate as night be agreed upon and any such renewals, extensions, modifications or change in the terms or rate of interest shall not impair in any minner the validity of or priority of this Mortgage, nor release the Mortgagor or any Co-Maker, surety or guarantor of the indebtedness secured hereby from personal liability, if assumed, for the indebtedness hereby secured.
