UNIFORM COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender covenant and agree as follows:

1. Payment of Principal and Interest; Propayment and Late Charges. Borrower shall promptly pay when

due the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment and late charges due under the Note.

2. Funds for Taxes and Insurance. Subject to applicable law or to a written waiver by Lender, Borrower shall pay to Lender on the day monthly payments are due under the Note, until the Note is paid in full, a sum ("Funds") equal to one-twelfth of: (a) yearly taxes and assessments which may attain priority over this Security Instrument; (b) yearly leasehold payments or ground rents on the Property, if any; (c) yearly hazard insurance premiums; and (d) yearly mortgage insurance premiums, if any. These items are called "escrow items." Lender may estimate the Funds due on the basis of current data and reasonable estimates of future escrow items.

The Funds shall be held in an institution the deposits or accounts of which are insured or guaranteed by a federal or state agency (including Londer if Londer is such an institution). Lender shall apply the Funds to pay the escrow items. Lender may not charge for holding and applying the Funds, analyzing the account or verifying the escrow items, unless Lender pays Borrower interest on the Funds and applicable law permits Lender to make such a charge. Borrower and Lender may agree in writing that interest shall be paid on the Funds. 3. Application of Payments. 4. Charges; Liens. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, times and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Borrower shall pay these obligations in the manner provided in paragraph 2, or if not paid in that manner, Borrower shall pay them on time directly to the person owed payment. Bor over shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts to be paid under this paragraph. If Borrower makes these payments directly, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing the payments.

Borrower shall promptly discharge any I en which has priority over this Security Instrument unless Borrower: (a) agrees in writing to the payment of the obligation secured by the lien in a manner acceptable to Lender; (b) contests in good faith the lien by, or defends against enforcement of the lien in, legal proceedings which in the Lender's opinion operate to prevent the enforcement of the lien or forfeiture of any part of the Property; or (c) secures from the holder of the lien an agreement satisfactory to Lender subordinating the lien to his Security Instrument. 5. Hazard Insurance. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by lire, hazards included within the term "exterded coverage" and any other hazards for which Lender requires insurance. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lender requires. The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's approval which shall not be unreasonably

All insurance policies and renewals shall be acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals. If Londer requires, Dorrewer shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid premiums and renewal notices. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and

Lender, Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Unless Londer and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, insurance proceeds sha's by applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged, if the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lende's accurity is not lessened. If the restoration or ropair is not economically teasible or Lender's security would be lessaned, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with a y excess paid to Borrower. If Borrower abandons the Property, or does not answer within 30 days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claim, then Lender may collect the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The 3ft dry period will begin when the notice is given.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of the payments. If under paragraph 19 the Property is acquired by Lendor, Borrower's right to any insurance policies and proceeds resulting from damage to the Property prior to the acquisition shall pass to Lender to the extent of the sums secured by this Security

Instrument immediately prior to the acquisition. 6. Preservation and Maintenance of Property; Leaseholds. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or substantially change the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate or commit waste. If this Security Instrument is on a leasehold, Borrower shall comply with the provisions of the lease, and if Borrower acquires fee title to the Property, the leasehold and fee title shall not merge unless Lender agrees to the merger in writing.

7. Protoction of Lender's Rights in the Property; Mortgage Insurance. If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or to enforce laws or regulations), then Lender may do and pay for whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. Lender's actions may include paying any sums secured by a lien which has priority over this Security Instrument, appearing in court, paying reasonable attorneys' fees and entering on the Property to make repairs. Although Lender may take action under this paragraph 7, Lender does not have to do so.

Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this paragraph 7 shall become additional debt of Borrower secured by this Security Instrument. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, these amounts shall bear interest from the date of disbursement at the Note rate and shall be payable, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting

8. Inspection. Lender or its agent may make reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property. Lender shall

give Borrower notice at the time of or prior to an inspection specifying reasonable cause for the inspection.

9. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of any part of the Property, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender.

In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing, the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall be reduced by the amount of the proceeds multiplied by the following fraction: (a) the total amount of the sums secured immediately before the taking, divided by (b) the fair market value of the Property immediately before the taking. If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or it, after notice by Lender to Borrower that the condemnor offers to make an award or settle a claim for damages, Borrower fails to respond to Lender within 30 days after the date the notice is given, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the proceeds, at its option, either to restoration or repair of the Property or

to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or

postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of such payments.

10. Borrow r Not Released; Forbearance By Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any successor in interest or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or Borrower, successors in interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or preclude the exercise of any right or remedy.

11. Successors and Assigns Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrower's covenant and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who consigns this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under in terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with e-gard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that

Borrower's consent.

12, Loan Charges, If the toan secured by his Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum toan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any with loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be retunded to Borrower. 16. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this You'tly Instrument.

17. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. If all or any part of me Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Londer's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in will of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by lederal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. 18. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. 10-YEAR BALLOON RIDER

(Conditional Modification & Extension of Loan Terms)

THIS 10-YEAR BALLOON RIDER (the "Rider") is made this 281H day of FEBRUARY, 1990 and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Security Deed (the "Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned (the "Borrower" or "I") to secure the Borrower's Balloon Note (the "Note") to SEARS MORIGAGE CORPORATION. AN OHIO CORPORATION

(the "Lender") of the same date and

covering the property described in the Security Instrument and located at:

535 E. HICKORY STREET, HINSDALE, ILLINOIS 60521

Property Address

The interest rate stated on the Note is called the "Note Rate". The date of the Note is called the "Note Date". I understand the Lender may transfer the Note, Security Instrument and this Rider. The Lender or anyone who takes the vote, the Security Instrument and this Rider by transfer and who is entitled to receive payments under the Note is called the "Note Holder".

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS: In addition to the covenants and agreements in the Note and the Security Instrument, the Parlower and the Lender further covenant and agree as follows (notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained or the Note or Security Instrument):

1. CONDITIONAL MODIFICATION AND EXTENSION OF LOAN TERMS

At the maturity date of the Note and Security Instrument (the "Maturity Date") I will have the option to extend the Maturity Date 30 years and modify the Note Rate to a market level adjustable rate as determined in accordance with Section 3 below, if all the conditions provided in Section 2 below are met (the "Conditional Modification and Extension Option"), it is derived the Note Holder is under no obligation to refinance or modify the Note, or to extend the Maturity Date, if those conditions are not met; and that in such event I will have to repay the Note from my own resources or find a lender willing to lend me the money to repay the Note.

2. CONDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

If I want to exercise the Conditional Modification and Extension Option at maturity, certain conditions must be met as of the Maturity Date. These conditions are: (1) I must still be the owner and occupant of the property subject to the Security Instrument (the "Proverty"); (2) I must be current in my monthly payments and CANNOT have been more than 30 days late on any 11 the 12 scheduled payments immediately preceding the Maturity Date; (3) no lien against the Property (except for taxes and special assessments not yet due and payable) other than the Security Instrument may exist; (1) he Initial Modified Note Rate, as defined and calculated in Section 3 below, cannot be more than five percent (5%) above the Note Rate; (5) I must make a written request to the Note Holder as provided in Section 5 below; (6) I must pay to the Note Holder a non-refundable extension processing fee equal to one-quarter of one percentage point (0.25%) of the outstanding principal balance as of the Maturity Date, unless prohibited by applicable law; and (7) I must execute a modification agreement to extend the Maturity Date and establish the Initial Modified Note Rate.

3. CALCULATING THE INITIAL MODIFIED NOTE RATE

The Initial Modified Note Rate will be a rate of interest equal to the poster. Sears Mortgage Securities Corporation required net yield for a One Year Treasury Adjustable Rate Mortgage with a maturity of 30 years for a 60 day mandatory delivery, plus one-half of one percentage point (0.500%), rounced fown to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%) (the "Initial Modified Note Rate"). The required point (pied shall be the applicable published not yield in effect on the date that I notify the Note Holder in writing of my election to exercise the Conditional Modification and Extension Option. If this required net yield caural be determined because Soars Mortgage Securities Corporation does not have a posted net yield for a One Year Treasury Adjustable Rate Mortgage with a maturity of 30 years, the Note Holder will determine the interest rate by using comparable information.

I understand that the Initial Modified Note Rate may change on each one year anniversary of the date the modification is executed. The Modified Note Rate will be based on an Index and calculated by adding the then current Margin to the Current Index and rounding the sum to the nearest one eighth of one percent (0.125%). The "Index" will be the weekly average yield on United States Treasury securities adjusted to a constant maturity of 1 year, as made available by the Federal Reserve Board. The most recent Index figure available, as of the date 45 days before each anniversary of the modification, will be called the "Current Index". The "Margin" will be the number of percentage points that will be added to the Index to calculate the interest rate at each adjustment. The margin that will apply to your loan, in the event you elect to exercise the extension, will be disclosed to you within 60 days of the maturity date, in the Notice of Extension Option.

4. CALCULATING THE NEW PAYMENT AMOUNT

Provided the Initial Modified Note Rate as calculated in Section 3 above is not greater than five percent (5%) above the Note Rate and all other conditions required in Section 2 above are satisfied, the Note Holder will

determine the amount of the monthly payment that will be sufficient to repay in full (a) the unpaid principal, plus (b) accrued but unpaid interest I will owe on the Maturity Date (assuming my monthly payments then are current, as required under Section 2 above), over 30 years at the Initial Modified Note Rate in equal monthly payments. The result of this calculation will be the new amount of my principal and interest payment every month until the first adjustment of the Modified Note Rate pursuant to the Modification Agreement to be executed at the time the Conditional Modification and Extension Option is exercised.

5. EXERCISING THE CONDITIONAL MODIFICATION AND EXTENSION OPTION

The Note Holder will notify me at least 60 calendar days in advance of the Maturity Date and advise me of the principal and unpaid interest due on the Maturity Date. The Note Holder will also provide me with a description of the historical performance of the Index and inform me of the maximum interest rate and payment which may be due under the Modified Note Rate. The Note Holder also will advise me that I may exercise the Conditional Modification and Extension Option if the conditions in Section 2 above are net. The Note Holder will provide my payment record information, together with the name, title and address of the person representing the Note Holder that I must notify in order to exercise the Conditional Modification and Extension Option. If I meet the conditions of Section 2 above, I may exercise the Conditional Modification and Extension Option by willying the Note Holder no later than 45 calendar days prior to the Maturity Date. The Note Holder will reliculate the Initial Modified Note Rate in accordance with Section 3 above. I will then have 30 calendar days to provide the Note Holder with acceptable proof of my required ownership, occupancy and property lien status. Before the Maturity Date the Note Holder will advise me of the new interest rate (the Initial Modified Note Pate), new monthly payment amount and a date, time and place at which I must appear to sign any documents equired to complete the required note modification and Maturity Date extension.
