To have and to hold the same unto the Assignee, its successors and assigns, until formination of this Assignment as hereinafter provided; Subject, however, to the right hereby granted by Assignee to Assigner to collect and receive the Rests, prior to the occurrence of a default herounder; provided, however, that this right is limited as hereinglier set forth.

In order to protect the security of the Assignment, Assignor covenants and agrees as follows:

I. Assignor's Representation and Warranties Concerning Leases and Rents. Truston represents and the Federiciary represents and warrants, if Property is vested in a land trust as of the date hereof and as of all dates hereafter, that:

(I) Assignor has not received any funds or deposits from any tenant for which credit has not already been made on account of accrued rents. This paragraph does not apply to security deposits.

(g) The tenants under the identified Leases and all other existing leases are not in default of any of the terms theref.

(g) The tenting under the tenting Leases and all other existing leases are not in detault or any of the terms therei.

2. Assignor's Covenants of Performance. Assignor covenants and agrees to:

(a) Observe, perform and fulfill, duly and punctually, all the obligations, terms, covenants, conditions and warranties of the Note, Mortgage, other Loan Documents and the Leases that Assignor is to keep, observe and perform, and give prompt notice to Assignee of any failure on the part of Assigner to observe, perform and discharge the same;

(b) Give prompt notice to Assignee of any notice, demand or other document received by Assignor from any tenant or subtenant under the Leases specifying any default claimed to have been made by the Assigner under the Leases;

(c) Enforce or secure the performance of each and every obligation, term, covenant, condition, and warranty in the Leases to be performed or fulfilled by any tenant, and notify Assignee of the occurrence of any default under the Leases;

(d) Appear in and defend any action or proceeding arising under occurring out of, or in any manner connected with the Leases, or the obligations, duties or liabilities of Assigner and any tenant thereunder;
(e) Pay all costs and expenses of Assignee, including attorneys' fees, in any action or proceeding in which Assignee may appear

4: Rejection of Leases. In the event any lessee under the Leases should be the subject of any proceeding under the Federal Bankruptcy Act of any biher federal, state, or local statute which provides for the possible termination or rejection of the Leases assigned hereby, Assignor covenants and agrees that if any of the Leases is so rejected, no settlement for damages shall be made without the prior written consent of the Assignee, and any check in payment of damages for rejection of any such Lease will be made payable both to the Assigner and Assignee. Assignee has upon the request of Assignee, it will duly endorse to the order of Assignee any such check, the proceeds of which will be applied to whatever portion of the indebtedness secured by this Assignment as Assignee may elect.

(a) To terminate the right granted to Assignor to collect the Fonts without taking possession, and to demand, collect, receive, sue for, attack and lovy against the Rents in Assignee's own nam /; to give proper receipts, releases and acquittances therefor; and after deducting all necessary costs and expenses of operation and collection, including attorneys' less, to apply the net proceeds thereof, together with any funds of Assignor deposited with Assignee, upon any indebtedness secured hereby in such order as Assignee may determine, and this Assignment shall constitute a direction to and full at northy to any lesses, tenant or other third-party who has heretofore dealt or may hereafter deal with Assigner or Assignee, at the require and direction of Assignee, to pay all Rents owing under any lease or other agreement to the Assignee without proof of the default relied upon, and any such lessee, tenant or third-party is hereby irrevocably authorized to rely upon and comply with (and shall be fully projected by Assigner in so doing) any request, notice or demand by the Assignee for the payment to the Assignee of any Rents or other sums which may be or may thereafter become due under its lease or other agreement, or for the performance of any undertakings under any such lease or other agreement, and shall have no duty to inquire as to whether any default hereunder or under the Loan Focurrents has actually occurred or is then existing;

(b) To declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable and, at its option, exercise all or any of the rights and remedies

Should Assignee incur any such liability, loss, damage or expense, the amount thereof, including attorneys' fees, with interest thereon at the Default Rate set forth in the Note, shall be payable by Assigner immediately without demand, and shall be secured as a lien hereby and by the Mortgage.

11. Records. Until the indebtedness secured hereby shall have been paid in full, Assignor shall deliver to Assignee executed copies of any and all Leases and all future Leases upon all or any part of the Premisos, and will, if Assignee requests, specifically transfer and assign such Leases upon the same terms and conditions as herein contained, but Assignor acknowledges and agrees that such specific assignment and transfer shall not be required to make this Assignment operative with respect to such future Leases. Assignor hereby covenants and agrees to make, execute and deliver to Assignee upon demand and at any time any and all further or additional assignments, documents and other records and instruments, including, but not limited to, rent rolls and books of account sufficient for the purpose, that Assignee

The failure of Assignee to avail itself of any of the terms, covenants and conditions of this Assignment for any period of time or at any time shall not be construed or deemed to be a waiver of any such right, and nothing herein contained nor anything done or omitted to be done by Assignee pursuant hereto shall be deemed a waiver by Assignee of any of its rights and remedies under the Note, Mortgage or other Loan Documents, or the laws of the state in which the said Premises are situated. The rights of Assignee to collect the indebtedness secur a hereby, to enforce any other security thereon, or to enforce any other right or remedy hereunder may be exercised by Assignee elitier prior to, simultaneously with, or subsequent to, any other action taken hereunder and shall not be deemed an election of remedies.

13. Primary Security.
