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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS MORTGAGE):

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other tiens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagee, (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer
 service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagee duplicatereceipts therefor,
 To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors
 may desire to contest.
- 3. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of illinois deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon the Mortgages the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagors, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgages in the mortgages or the mortgages, then and in any such event, the Mortgagors, upon demand by the Mortgages, shall pay such laxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgages therefor, provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgages (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagors to make such payment or to the maximum amount permitted by taw, then and in such event, the Mortgage may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagors, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.
- 4. If, by the laws of the United States of America or of any state having jurisdiction in the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the noty for by secured, the Mortgagors covenant and agree to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagors further covenant to hold harmless and agree to indemnify the Mortgagoe, and the Mortgagoe's successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the note secured hereby.
- 5. At such time as the Mortranois are not in default either under the terms of the note secured hereby or under the terms of this mortgage, the Mortgagors shall have such prividing of making prepayments on the principal of said note (in addition to the required payments) as may be provided in said note.
- 6. Mortgagors shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and windstorm under policies proving for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or replacing the same or to pay in full the individuals secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagee, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee, such fights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy, and shall deliver all policies, including additional and feners, policies, to the Mortgagee, and in case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.
- 7. In case of default therein, Mortgages may, considered, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and mainer deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make for or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, andpurchase, discharge, compromise or sottle any tax tien or other prior title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or foreiture affecting said premises or context any tax or assessment. All moneys prid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therawith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys way incoded by Mortgages to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indeptedness secured hereby and shall become it imediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the highest rate now permitted by tillinois law. Inaction of Mortgages shall not ver be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to the Mortgages on account of any default horeunder on the part of the Mortgagors.
- 8. The Mortpague making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the according to such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.
- 9. Mortgagers shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, both runsipal and interest, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Mortgagee and without notice to Mortgagers, all unpaid indebte ners secured by this mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable tal immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for increase any other agreement of the Mortgagers herein contained.
- 10. When the indebtedness nereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration of offerwise. Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any Suit 10 foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for altorneys less, appraiser's less, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stengraphers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimaled at to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches, and examinations, title insurance policies. Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem to be reasonably necessary either to produce a such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the product as and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and infinitely due and payable, with interest thereon at the highest rate now permitted by Illinois law, when paid or incurred by Mortgagee in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which the Mortgagee Shall be a pairty, either as plaintlift, claimant or defend. Thy teason of this mortgage or any indebtedness hereby secured, or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose or the security hereof.
- 11. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding para renhinered; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indeptedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with informatives or assigns, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagors, their heirs, legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 12. Upon or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage the court in which such complaint is filed may appear a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the said shall be then occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be redessary or are usual in such cases for the prefection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other her which may be obscome superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.
- 13. No action for the enforcement of the field or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the note hereby secured.
 - 14. The Mortgagee shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 15. The Mortgagors shall periodically deposit with the Mortgages such sums as the Mortgagee may reasonably require for payment of taxes and assessments on the premises. No such deposit shall bear any interest.
- 18. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in said promises, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their hability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by the Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release,
- 17. Mortgagee shall release this mortgage and lien thereof by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby and payment of a reasonable fee to Mortgagee for the execution of such release.
- 18. This mortgage and all provisions hereof, shall extend to and be binding upon Mortgagors and all persons claiming under or through Mortgagors, and the word "Mortgagors" when used herein shall include such persons and all persons tiable for the payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof, whether or not such persons shall have executed the note or this mortgage. The word "Mortgagee" when used herein shall include the successors and assigns of the Mortgagee named herein and the holder or holders, from time to time, of the note secured hereby.

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
