

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a fen in tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether redt or personal, belonging to cuch person.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is epecifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so secesed (or a judgment against the texpayor ensing out of such Sebility) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

96c. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Furchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests; Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The fien imposed by section 6321 shall flot be voild as against any purchaser, holder of a accurity laterest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien craditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been sed by the Secretary.

n Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed .

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one notice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(III Personal Property - Is the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to flen is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. the property subject to the fien is aituated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical incation; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property. ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpaye at the time the notice of her is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (5), the residence of a corporation or party with I shall be deemed to be the place at which the principel executive office of the business is located, and the restdence of a targer or whose residence is without the United States shall be us mad to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to In subsection (a) shall be proscribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid not. that thing any other provision of law regarding the form or context of a notice of lien.

(g) Refling Of Notice. - For purposes of this

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of fien is relified In the mariner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled in accordance with subsection (I)) after the expiration of such refiling period
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of tien refiled during the required reliting period shall be effective unly -

(A)

- iii) such notice of son is relied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was lifed, and
- (ii) In the case of real property, the fact of retiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (I) (4), and
- (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a retiting of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary, concerning a change in the tarpayer's residence, if a notice of such lies elia dies in accordance with subsection (I) in the State in which such residence is located.

(a) Required Refilling Period.—in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required reffling period" means . (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expirat in of B years effor the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice at lien.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Oi Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not fater than 30 days after the day on

(1) Usbritty Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all intorest in respect thereof has been fully satisfied or has become

(2) Bond Accepted There is lumished to the Secretary and arcopted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment ni the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof many the time prescribed by taw (including any axionsion of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements reliable to forms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties the eor, at may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.-
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding fien.-If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such her may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a night in such property.
