Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the smount (including any interest, addisonal amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a Son in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is appellically fixed by law, the fien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall confinue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgrpent against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Machanic's Lienors, And Judgment then Creditors, - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall but be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's flenor, or judgment lien creditor until notice that of which meets the requirements of subsoction (f) has been alled by the Secretary.

m Place For Filling Notice; Form. -

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one g office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(a) Parsonal Property - In the case of personal prop erty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other povernmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property aublect to the fien is altusted; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of suborragraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Directs of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is altuated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property. whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxlever it the time the notice of iten is fued.

For surposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive of on the business is located, and the rasidence of a Laxor yer whose residence is without the United States shall be draw and to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form the content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall 'e preconced by the Secretary. Such notice shall be velid notwith tending any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lian.

(p) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this section

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of hen is reflied In the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of item shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (i)) after the expiration of such relising period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(i) such notice of tien is railled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was flied, and

(N) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(8) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of iten under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State In which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period.-- (5 1% case of any notice of lian, the term "required refiling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expitation of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of Her.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such sugulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any minimal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully extistled or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Band Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and scorpted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, whilm the time prescribed by last (including any extension of such tire a), and that is in accordance with such requiremenis telling in terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties therein, is may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(a) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes. --

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such is... This, he disclosed to any parson who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to each lien or intende to obtain a right in such property.
