

Excerçis From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may account addition thereto) shall be a feel in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the first imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so seasesed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

\$4c. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The len imposed by section 321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Socretary.

in Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(f) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one a soffice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), se designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Cf Destrict Court in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, wherever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deads Of The District Of Columbia. In the office of the Recorder of Deads of the District of Columbia, it the property subject to the item is situated in the District of

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be insectived by the Secretary. Such notice shall be yatid notion—at using any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule.—Unless notice of lien to reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as fried on the date on which it is filled un accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of iten refiled during the required retiling period shall be effective only -

(A) #

- (i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the pnor notice of lien was filed, and
- (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
- (B) in any case in which, 60 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received virties information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the laxystyar's rasidence, it a notice of such tien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such researce is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period.—in the case of any notice of tien, the term required refilling period means.

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refining period for such notice of ken.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a conflicate of release of any lich imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied of Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become logithy unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of it is amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, when the time precibed by law (including any extension of a job him?), and that is in acceptance with such requirements resulting to reims, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties therein, he may be specified by such regulations.

Sec 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lies. If a notice of lies has been filed pursuant to section 6323ff, the amount of the outstunding obligation secured by such lies may be disclosed to any person who furnishes califactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lies or intends to obtain a right in such paperty.
