

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Codo

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may socrue in addition thereto) shall be a fen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether realizer persons, helotoging to such person.

## Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the item imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

c. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Inserests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Light Creditors.—The lien imposed the eclosiassa shaffnet be valid as against any purchaser, holder in a security interest, mechanic's hence, or judgment lien credity until notice thereof which makes the requirements of subsection (f) has been just by the Secretary.

Piece For Filing - The notice reterred to in subsection
 (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Rest Property - in the case of real property, in one gloffice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as dealgrated by the laws of such State. In which the property subject to the lien is attuated; or

(B) With Clerk Of Cristrict Coun-in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to filen is altusted, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subcarracturin (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia. (2) Billus Of Property Bublect To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, meth in tangible or intenticide, at the residence of the taxcase at the time the notice of iten is filled.

For purprises of paragraph (2) (B) the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal execution of the business is located, and the residence of a saxpri, it whose residence is without the United States shall be derined to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The for cand content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwiths and it gany other provision of law regarding the form or content the votice of tien.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section -
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be freated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of lien refilled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(A) K-

- (i) such notice of iten is refilled in the office in which the prior notice of iten was filed, and
- (ii) In the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an Indax to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
- (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also field in accordance with subsection (if in the State in which such residence is located.

of any notice of tien, the term "required refiling period" means

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the superation of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lion Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any memal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability for this encount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and so seled by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all trierest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by lew (including any extension of upon this), and that is in accordance with such requirements reliamly to "ans. conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereof, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

- (a) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien, if a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(t), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such tien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
