THIS ADJUSTABLE RATE RIDER is made this 4TH day of MAY 19\_90, and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Secured Deed (the "Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned (the "Borrower") to secure Borrower's Adjustable Rate Note (the "Note") to CHASE HOME MORTGAGE CORPORATION a DELAWARE CORPORATION , (the "Lender") of the same date and covering the property described in the Security Instrument and located at:

THE NOTE PROVIDES FOR A CHANGE IN MY FIXED INTEREST RATE TO AN ADJUSTABLE INTEREST RATE. THE NOTE LIMITS THE AMOUNT THE INTEREST RATE CAN CHANGE AT ANY ONE TIME AND THE MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM RATES I MUST PAY.

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

#### A. INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

#### (A) Change Dates

The most recent Index figure available as of the date forty-five (45) days before each Change Date is called the "Current Index."

If the Index is no longer available, the Note Holder will choose a new index which is based upon comparable information. The Note Holder will give me notice of this choice.

#### (C) Calculation of Changes

Before each Change Date, the Note Holder will calculate my new interest rate by adding TWO AND THREE FOURTHS percentage points (2.75 %) to the Current Index. The Note Holder will then round the result of this addition to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). Subject to the limitations in paragraph (D) below, this rounded amount will be my new interest rate until the next Change Date.

The Note Holder will then determine the amount of the monthly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid principal that I am expected to owe at the Change Date in full on the maturity date at my new interest rate in

#### Limits on Interest Rate Changes

My adjustable interest rate will never be increased or decreased on any single Change Date more than two percentage points (2.00%) from the interest rate

I have been paying for the preceding 12 months.

There is a limit of six percentage points (6.00%) on the amount by which the interest rate may increase or decrease from the initial interest rate over the entire term of the loan. If a change in the Current Index would otherwise cause the new interest rate to exceed the two percentage points (2.00%) or the six percentage points (6.00%) rate adjustment limitations, the unused portion of such increase or decrease will not be carried forward and applied to change the rate in future years.
