AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE 33 FOOT WIDTH OF GREENLEAF AVENUE WEST OF LARAMIE AVENUE, THE 33 FOOT WIDTH OF 8

EREAS, Skokie School District 72 as the owners of the property abutting the 33 foot width of Greenleaf Avenue West of Laramie Avenue, the 33 foot width of Lunt Avenue West of Laramie Avenue and the 33 foot width of Lockwood Avenue between Greenleaf and Lunt Avenues in the Village of Skokie petitioned the Skokie Plan Commission for the vacation thereof; and

WHEREAS, the owners of all of the properties abutting the aforesaid property were duly notified of the Plan Commission proceedings and presented no objection to the proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, the Skokie Plan Commission, after public hearing duly held, recommended to the Mayor and Board of Trustees that said property be vacated subject to various conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Willage of Skokie, at a public meeting duly held, adopted the recommendations of the Skokie Plan Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Skokie, Cook County, Illinois:

Section 1: That the 33 foot width of Greenleaf Avenue West of Laramie Avenue, the 33 foot width of Lunt Avenue West of Laramie Avenue and the 33 foot width of Lockwood Avenue between Greenleaf and Lunt Avenues, in an R-2 Single-Family Residential

District be and the same are hereby vacated subject to all of the conditions set forth below:

- 1. That the Petitioners shall submit a Plat of Vacation for the subject portions of Lunt Avenue, Greenleaf Avenue and Lockwood Avenue;
- 2. All public service facilities now situated in that part of the streets hereby vacated, and the easements therefore, are hereby reserved to the public utilities owning the same; for continuing public service by means of such facilities; and for the use, maintenance, renewal and reconstruction of such facilities; unless such easements are formally abandoned (or relocated) by each of the affected utilities and the Village of Skokie duly notified;
- 3. Any easement referred to in Condition #2 above shall run with the land such easements shall be indicated on a revised Plat of Vication which shall be furnished by the Petitioner and recorded at the Petitioners' expense in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Cook County;
- 4. That an easement agreement shall be worked out between the school district and Kingston Estates subdivision for the maintenance of a private sanitary sewer line that traverses the southwest corner of Lockwood and Lunt Avenues. This easement shall be recorded at the Petitioners' expense in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Cook County; and
- 5. That in the event that any of the aforesaid conditions are violated, the subject property will revent back to Village of Skokie.

Section 2: That the aforesaid vacation shall be effective upon the recording of a Plat of Vacation to be furnished by the petitioners and recorded at the petitioners' expense in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County.

Section 3: That no compensation shall be paid by the owners of the abutting properties for the value of the real estate which may accrue to them by reason of the enactment of this ordinance.

Section 4: That a Notice of the enactment of this ordinance shall be approved and signed by all of the abutting owners and duly recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County at the petitioners' expense.
