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

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien ifn & posed by nection 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the tarpayer ansing out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unerstorceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's tienor, or judgment tien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subscribin (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(t) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Roal Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property autient to the flen is situated; and

(ii) Péleonal Entoeny In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has no by iaw dealgnated one office which mestarteepreparements. of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deads Of The District Of Columbia in the office of the Rocorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. I the property autiject to the lien is situated in the District of

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of tien is refilled In the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling neriod, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) effer the expiration of such reliting period.
- (2) Place For Filling. A motion of lian reflied during the required retiling period shall be effective only.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leave a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue lax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unantorceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all tolevest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforce, "le; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and some field by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such large, and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to erms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereou, he may be specified by such regulations.

> Sec. \$103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(a) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return' Information For Tax Administration Purposes.+

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lient-if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lion may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in auch property.
