All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned, and such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of said premises and the mair tenance of the lien of this mortgage, including the fees of any atterney employed by Mortgage in any litigation or proceeding affecting this Mortgage. 'S had not all premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparations for the commencement or defense of any proceeding or threatmed suit or proceedings, whether or not actually commenced, shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgage, with interest thereon at the releason to the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage and the same shall be secured by this Mortgage.
- 17. Application of Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, of (account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the proceeding paragraph hersoit, account, all other items which under the terms hersof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as her inc. provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth any overplus to Mortgagor, its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.
- 18. Appointment of Receiver. Upon, or at the time after the filling of a complaint to foreclose this Mortgage, the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of said premiser. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Mortgagor be of order or any holder of the Note may be appointed as such receiver. The Mortgagor represents and agrees that no rent has been or will be paid by any person in pormss' on of any portion of the above described premises for more than one installment in advance and that the payment of none of the rents to accrue for any portion of the said premises has been or will be waived, released, reduced, discounted or otherwise discharged or compromised by the Mortgagor. The Nortgagor waives any rights of set-off against any person in possession of any portion of the above described premises. If any lease provides for the above or not of rent during repair of the premises demised thereunder by reason of fire or other casualty, the Mortgagor shall furnish to the Mortgagor rents in urence, the policies to be in amount and form and written by such insurance companies as shall be satisfactory to the Mortgagor agrees that it will not assign any of the rents or profits of said premises, except to a purchaser or grantee of the premises.

The Mortgages shall not be obligated to perform or discharge, nor does it hereby undertake to perform or discharge, any obligation, duty or liability under any leases, and the Mortgager shall and does hereby agree to indemnify and hold the Mortgages harmless of and from any and all liability, loss or damage which it may or might incur under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment thereof and of and from any and all claims and demands whatsoever which may be asserted against it by reason of any alleged obligations or undertakings on its part to perform or discharge any of the terms,

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covenants or agreements contained in said leases. Should the Mortgagee incur any such liability, loss or damage, under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment thereof, or in the defense of any claims or demands, the amount thereof, including costs, expenses and reasonable attorney's fees, shall be secured hereby, and the Mortgagor shall reimburse the Mortgagee therefor immediately upon demand.

- 21. Application of Income Received by Mortgagee. The Mortgagee in the exercise of the rights and powers hereinabove conferred upon it by paragraph 19 and paragraph 20 hereof shall have full power to use and apply the avails, rents, issues and profits of the premises to the payment of or on account of the following, in such order as the Mortgagee may determine:

ALLY INTERESTED THEREIN, AND EACH AND EVERY PERSON ACQUIRING ANY INTEREST IN, OR TIPLE TO, THE PREMISES DIS CRIBED HEREIN SUBSEQUENT TO THE DATE OF THIS MORTGAGE, AND ON BEHALF OF ALL OTHER PERSONS TO THE EXTENT PERMIT ED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE ILLINOIS STATUTES.
- 29. Mortgagee's Lien for Service Charges and Expenses. At all times, regardless of whether any loan proceed. 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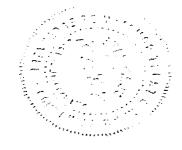
