

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay is after demand, the amount (including any interest, addisonal amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a fion in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether Yest or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless chether date is epecifically fixed by law, the lise imposed by section 8321 shalf laftle at the time the assistament is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so secued (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such fiability) is entialled or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(e) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The flon Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a recurity finitest, mechanic's tienar, or judgment lien creditor until notice theoret which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been Cod by the Secretary.

m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (it) shall be filed .

(A) Under State Laws
(B) Real Property - In the case of real property. In one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other povernmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the fier is situated; or

With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by taw designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Dueds Of The District Of Columbia, in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the field is attuated in the District of

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(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Unn - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be shuated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical incation: or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengiole, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of tion is flied.

(3) Form . The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Sincretary Such notice shall be valid notivitial runing any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of Sen.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiting period.
- (2) Place For Filling. A hotice of then refiled during the required reliting period shall be effective only

(A) if-

(i) such notice of field is reflect in the cifficia in jurisch is the prior notice of field was fitted, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reffling its entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(6) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of fien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the mainter pay acribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such the is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(s) Required Refilling Period. -- in the sale of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax; and (B) the one-year period ending with the application of 6 years after the close of the preceding required retiting period for such notice of lien, . .

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall Issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not fater than 30 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully estisfied or has become

legally unenforceable; or (2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and sorthed by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment (i) to amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, Viscon the time prescribed by law (including any extenalon of such thie), and that is in accordance with such requirements reinting for terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suraties thercon as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(a) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Burnoses. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien.-if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
