

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accuse in addition thereto) shall be a fen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether right of personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the liter imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such fability) is safested or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests; Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors, —The ilen imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's bears, or judgment lien creditor until notice thesest which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been flight by the Secretary.

a Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental succlusion, as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the sen is effected;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clerk
of the United States district count for the judicial district in which
the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has
not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

of subparagraph (A), cr

(G) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The Gigtnet-Ch(Columbia, in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Sen is situated in the District of Columbia.

For proces of paragraph (2) (3), the residence of a corporation or party step shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal execution of the of the business is located, and the residence of a corporar whose residence is without the United States shall be de med to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwing funding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of tien.

(g) Refilling Of Notice. — For purposes of this

- (1) **General Rule.**—Unless notice of then its reliad in the munner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (ii) after the expiration of such rething period.
- (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of Sen refilled during the recurror refers period shall be effective only.

(ii) In the case of real property, the fact of refilling is ordered and recorded in an index to the extent required by

"Secretary received written information (in the manner plasorbed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpeyer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the Stille in which such residence is located.

(s) Required Refilling Pariod. -- in the other of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required reftting period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a perificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the Pablity for the amount essessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully astisfied or has become

iegaliy unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment it is amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, with the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such fir is), and that is in secondance with such regularments tealing to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

 O) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstending lien. If a notice of tien has been filled pursuent to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstending obligation secured by such tien may be discussed to any porson who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property.
