#### MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED JULY 13, 1990, between Gregory W. Perry and Joiene L. Perry, , Married, whose address is 8524 W. Crarry Creek Avenue, Tinley Park, IL 60477 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and Heritage Bank Tinley Park, whose address is 17500 Oak Park Avenue, Tinley Park, IL 60477 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgages, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real propery, logister with all existing or subsequently snected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all essements, rights of way, and apputenances, a water, water rights, watercourses and click rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royaltes, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar massers, located in Cook County, State of Illinois (the "Real Property"):

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 8524 W. Cherry Creek Avenue, Tinley Park, IL 60477. The Real Property tax identification number is 27-26-116-004.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in 2nd to all lesses of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest of any Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving line of credit a peen ent dated July 13, 1990, between Lander and Grantor with a credit limit of \$25,000.00, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account belance on all a rate of 11.750% per annum.

Existing Indebtedness. The words "Existing Indebtedness" mean the Indebtedness describer, by an in the Existing Indebtedness section of this Mortgage.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means Gregory W. Perry and Jolene L. Perry. The Grantor is the mortgign under this Mortgage.

Guarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation each and all of the guarantors, ures is, and accommodation parties in connection with the Indebtedness.

Improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agreement and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to decharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without limitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit, which obligates Lender to make advances to Grantor so long as Grantor compiles with all the terms of the Credit Agreement. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the limitation that the total outstanding balance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such belience at a fixed or variable rate or sum as provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in this paragraph, shall not exceed the Credit Limit as provided in the Credit Agreement. It is the Intention of Grantor and Lender that this Mortgage secures the balance outstanding under the Credit Agreement from time to time from zero up to the Credit Limit as provided above and any intermediate balance. The lien of this Mortgage shall not exceed at any one time \$25,000.00.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regrissions, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in proof faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Granton has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Edsting Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within fileen

(15) days after the tien arises or, if a tien is filled, within filteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filling, secure the discharge of the fier, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' less or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obliges under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Grantor shall notify Lender at least filteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any machanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$2,500.00. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurence. Grantor shell procure and maintain policies of fire insurence with etandard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement by as by the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any colinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lander. Policies shell be written by such insurence companies and in such form as may be respinably acceptable to Lander. Grantor shell deliver to Lander certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage with not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lander.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. Existing Uen. The lien of this Mortgage securing the Indebtedness may be secondary and inferior to an existing lien. Grantor expressly covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

No Modification. Grantor shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which that agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lander. Grantor shall neither request nor accept any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lander.

CONDEANNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by entinent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in tieu of condemnation, Lander may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' less necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor or Lander in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such

steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be emitted to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by courset of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whetever other action is requested by Lender to partect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, documentary starrips, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shell constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Credit Agreement; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Tizzes. If any zex to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event A Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its evaluable remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless (2 an either (e) paye the tax before it becomes definquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FRANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Interest. Upon request by ander, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Londer to perfect and continue Lender's security in and in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and and an interest continuing the security interest. Grantor, shell executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following p ovisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Pelault") under this Mortgage: (a) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, Sebilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the replayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the colleteral for the credit line account or Lender's rights in the colleteral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay taxes, death of all persons Sable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a sen on the dwelling without Lender's permission, foreclosure by the holder of another lien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time theresher, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lander shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take

possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by taw. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lander shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Forectoeurs. Lander may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Credit Agreement or available at law or in equity.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be tree to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or \$\psi\$ separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Ander shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any privace also or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Watver; Election of Re Andles. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to domain series compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other contents, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after taiture of Grantor to perform this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. It Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at stall and on any appeal. NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Mortgage, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to all addresses shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any flan which has priority over this Mortgage shall be sent to Lander's address, as shown pear the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor accept to keep Lender informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

ANSCELLAMEOUS PROVISIONS. The lollowing miscellaneous provisions are a principlinis Mortgage:

Amendments. This Mortgage, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the conice understanding and agreement of the parties as to the metters set forth in this Mortgage. No alteration of or amendment to this Mortgage shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Illinois. Subject to the provisions on arbitration, this Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the lay and the State of Illinois.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Marger. There shall be no marger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other into set o estate in the Property at any time hald by or for the benefit of Legder in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Multiple Parties. At obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall meen each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Mortgage.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unanforced as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unanforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity, however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricten and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Successors and Aseigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon, and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. Walver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Elinois as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such waiver is in welling and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such alphir or any letter right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right of themseld strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lander and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.
