Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether rest or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another plate is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 5321 shall arise at the time the assessrent is made and shall continue until the liability for the mount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of sucts liability) is satisfied or becomes unanforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Credifors. The sen impos-ed by section 6321 shall not be valed an ageinst any purchasar, holder of a security interest, mechanic's tenor, or sudoments of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary,

(1) Place For Filing - The notice reterred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws
(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or oth governmental subdivision), as designated by the tews of such State, in which the property subject to the fier is attracted and

property, whether tangicle or intemptile, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ken is altusted; except that State law merely conforming to reenecting Federal law establishing a national filing system does not constitute a second uffice for filing as designated by the laws of such State; or (B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the

clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is altusted, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of supparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Doeds Of The District Of Coribia - in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Bitus Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated-(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(Ph Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether sangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time ine notice of tien is fried.

Fc purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or purposed to be the place at which the princips are outive office of the business is located, and the residence of a til xpryer whose residence is without the United States shall be up med to be in the District of Columbia.

(a) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lier; shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in eccordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of tien refiled during the required reffling period shall be effective only-

(i) such notice of lien is retiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of refiling is entored and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a continuate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secrotory finds that the liability for the amount assessed, togethor with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully eatistied

or has become legally unonforceable, or

(2) Bond Accopted - There is furnished to the Secretery and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon ti v) sympat of the amount assessed, together with all inte in expect thereof, within the time prescribed by lew (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with I iquirer ents relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and wireles thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.-

(2) Disolosure of amount of outstanding here of a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such flatt may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory. written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to auch lien or intends to obtain a right in auch property.
