Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes

If any person fiable to day any tax neglects or refuses to hathe same after domand, the amount (noticing any interest additional amount, addition to tox, or aspectable penalty, logather with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a flor in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to auch person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shell area at the time the assessment is made and shall condition trait that detailing for this grount so aspessed (or a judgment against the laxipayer arising out of such liability) is settified or occomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of toni property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental substriction), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property in the case of porsonal property, whether tanglets or imangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property applied to the lien is situated; except that State law mannly conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national tiling system does not consiltute a second office for filing

as designated by the laws of such State; or
(B) With Clark Of District Court-in the office of the other of the United States district court-for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is studied, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the regularments of subparagraph (4), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia. (2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated-(A) Peal Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location or

Di Personal Property. In the case of personal property, whether tangente or intengible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the nauce of tien is filed.

Fir purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partitionally shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal appropriate office of the business is located, and the residence (i all only yet whose residence is without the United States shall be firmly a do in the District of Columbia.

... (3) Form - he form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be a sacribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid in withstanding any other provision of low regarding the form of content of a notice of line.

ig) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section.

(1) General Rule.—Unless notice of ifen is reffiod in the manner prescribed in puragraph (2) during the required
refilling period, such notice of nen shall be treated as filed on the
date on which it is tilled (in accordance with subsection (f) after
the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filing.—A notice of then refilled during the required retilling period shall be effective only-

(A) II-

(i) such notice of lian is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lian was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of rolling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayar's residence, it is also illed in accordance with subsection (i) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period"

(A) the one-year period anding 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(8) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required raffling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien! Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such requiations as the Secretary may proscribe, the Secretary shall leave a cartificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in pages (Thersol, has been fully satisfied or

has become lagally unaniprosable; of

(2) Bond Accepted There is lumished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, logather with all interest mere prescribed by law (including any or ansice of such time), and that is in accordance with such matter as relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and survivales thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Fleturns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien,41. a notice of tien has been filled pursuant to another 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any person who (umishes satisfaplor) written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
