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#### CLAIM FOR LIEN

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned Claimant, Palatine Builders Supply, Inc. ("Palatine"), of Rolling Meadows, Illinois, by its duly authorized agent, claims a mechanic's lien under the law entitled "An Act relating to contractors' materialmen's liens, known as mechanics' liens," Ill. Rev. Stat. ch. 82, para. 1 et seq., and states:

1. In early March, 1991, Palating entered into an oral contract with G & D Construction & Maintenance ("G & D Construction") of Chicago, Illinois, under and by which Palatine agreed to supply certain materials and equipment including hollow metal frame tags, hollow metal door tags, wood studs, wire masonry, butts, locks, trim, weather strip, dust proof strike, exit devices, closures and roller latches, for use in the remodeling of a building commonly known as Van Stranten Gallery, 742 North Wells Street, Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, legally described as:

Lot 4 in Resubdivision of Lots 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 in Block 18 in Newberry's Addition to Chicago in Section 9, Township 39 North, Range 14, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois,

of which the then owner, Lakeside Bank, as Trustee under Trust Agreement dated March 5, 1990 known as Trust #10-1443, knowingly permitted G & D Construction to make the contract and erect improvement thereon.

- 2. The contract did not provide a specific date on or before which the materials and equipment were to be supplied.
- 3. G & D Construction agreed to pay Palatine \$7,964.07 to supply the materials and equipment G & D Construction specified, which sum was to be paid upon several dates.
- 4. Palatine furnished all of the materials and equipment G & D Construction ordered and it delivered that material and equipment to, and that material and equipment was to be used in, about and for, the improvement of the above-described building.
- 5. Palatine delivered the last of the materials and equipment G & D ordered on or about April 18, 1991.
- 6. There is now owing to Palatine, for furnishing and delivering the referenced material and equipment, after allowing the Owner all just credits, deductions and setoffs, the sum of \$7,213.07, all of which is still due and unpaid; all as per the account attached hereto as Exhibit A.
