Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount cincluding any interest, additional amount, addition to tax or assissable penalty. together with any costs that may accrue in addition theretol tibe a lien in favor of the United States upon all prop and rights to property, whether reaf or pursonal, belonging to

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lian smooted by section 6301 shall arms at the time the assessment is made and shall continue unto the rabity for the emount so assessed (or a progress makes the lampayer arising out of such kability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasel's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors,-The sen moosad by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanics lienter, or judgment lien craditor until notice thereof which mosts the requesments of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary.

(a) Release Of Lien, — Subject to such report lations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of rolonse of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(*) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Socretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, togeth or with all interest in respect thereof, has been ally satisfied

or has become largestly unenforceable or (2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accorpted by him a bond that is conditioned upon this pyment of the amount assessed, together with all interest e, aspect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any exiension of such time), and that is in accordance with such it guirer ears relating to terms, conditions, and form of the band and acrows thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.
