

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Crue

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person haute to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, soddional amount, addition to tax, or essessable benaity, together, with any costs that may appear in eachion thereby thall be alien in tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property whether roal or personal, belonging to such person. [7(1):14(2):15(2)] in the fire

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by taw, the fire imposed by section 6321 shell arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the fability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such habitity) is satisfied or bucomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The ten imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as egainst any purchase or, holder of a security finerest, mechanic's floor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which mosts the requirement of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

 Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed.

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the tool is still stand.

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the tien is reflueted; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national thing system does not constitute a second office for filling

as designated by the taws of such State; or (IB), With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lion is aduated, whenever the State has not by taw designated one office which meets the

requirements of supparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Doeds Of The District Of Columbia. In the office of the Recorder of Doeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is shunted in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated-(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(f) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether temploie or intengible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the timil the lictics of lien is fixed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be desired to be the place at which the principal manufactorial office of the business is located, and the residence of a true payer whose residence is without the United States shall be disclosed to be in the District of Columbia.

States shall be discused to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - Tire form the crimitans of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be proscribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be vaid not subsecting any other provision of law regarding the form or content of inotice of lien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section-

(i) General Rule.—Unless notice of lion is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refling period.

(2) Place For Filling.—A notice of ban refuse during the required refuling period chall be effective only-

(A) if-

Ill such notice of lien is refued in the office in which the prior name of lien was filed, and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

(a) Required Refilling Period.—in the case of any notice of lien, the term required refilling period means.

(A) the one-year period unding 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(8) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the procedurg required refiling period for such notice of tion.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such regutations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of rolease of any flen imposed with respect to any Internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which:

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with affilinerest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the Layment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in esper. Thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any as assion of such time), and that is in accordance with such mounts in a relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond arms of used thereon, as may be specified by such

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding field, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6325(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who turnishes assistanting written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
