Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of the original Borrower or Borrower's successors in interest. 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10. Successors and Assigns Bound, Joint and Several Liability, Co-signers. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower subject to the provisions of paragraph 15. If there is more than one party as Borrower, each of Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Agreement, as well as signing this Security Instrument, only to mortgage, grant and convey this Borrower's interest in the Property to the terms of this Security Instrument, is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument, and Lender and any co-signer of Borrower may agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Agreement without that Borrower's consent.

11. Loan Charges. The loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is hereby interpreted so that the interest, other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed the permitted limits then in any such law, judgment, hereinafter provided by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit, and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceed permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Agreement or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Agreement.

12. Notices. Any notice to be given pursuant to this Security Instrument shall be given by delivery in person or by mailing it by first class mail, unless appropriate law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates to the Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates to the Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.

13. Governing Law; Severability. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of Illinois. In the event that any provision of this Security Instrument or the Agreement conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Agreement which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Agreement are intended to be severable.

14. Assignment by Lender. Lender may assign all or any portion of its interest hereunder and its rights granted herein and in the Agreement to any person, trust, partnership or other entity, in whole or in part, as Lender may determine and upon such assignment, such assignee shall thereupon succeed to all the rights, interests and equities of Lender herein and in the Agreement, and Lender shall thereupon have no further obligations or liabilities thereunder.

15. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower; Due on Sale. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred, or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may at its option require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed, within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument or the Agreement without further notice or demand on Borrower.

16. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. If Borrower meets certain conditions, Borrower shall have the right to have enforcement of this Security Instrument discontinued at any time prior to the entry of a judgment enforcing this Security Instrument. Those conditions are that Borrower: (a) pays under the terms of the Agreement all sums due under this Security Instrument and the Agreement had no acceleration occurred; (b) cures any default in any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including but not limited to the costs of any foreclosure sale and Lender may reasonably require to assure that the lien of this Security Instrument is perfected against the property and its successors; (d) pays the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall on time unchanged; and (e) cures the previous default more frequently than once every five years. 17. Prior Mortgage. Borrower shall not be in default of any provision of any prior mortgage.

18. Acceleration Remedies. Lender shall give notice to Borrower prior to acceleration following: (a) Borrower's fraud or material misrepresentation in connection with this Security Instrument or the Agreement or the Equity Credit Line evidenced by the Agreement; (b) Borrower's failure to meet the payment terms of the Agreement; (c) Borrower's sale, lease, encumbrances which adversely affect the Property or any right Lender has in the Property; or (d) failure to cure the default or acceleration under paragraph 15, unless applicable law provides otherwise. The notice shall specify the default, the action required to cure the default on a date not less than 30 days from the date the notice is given to Borrower by which the default must be cured, and that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Security Instrument, foreclosure by judicial proceeding and sale of the Property. The notice shall further inform Borrower of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in the foreclosure proceeding the nonexistence of a default or any other defense of Borrower to acceleration and foreclosure. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as constituting Lender a mortgagee in possession in the absence of the taking of actual possession of the Property by Lender pursuant to Paragraph 19. 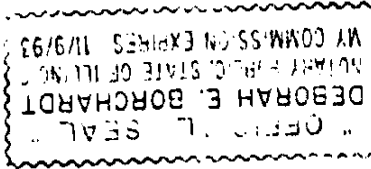

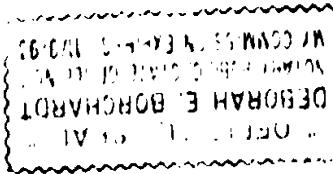
