## Notice of Federal Tax Lien Under Internal Revenue Laws

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As provided by sections 6321, 6322, and 6323 of the Internal Revenue Code, notice is given that taxes (including interest and penalties) have been assessed against the following-named taxpayer. 

### Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount, including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto, shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

#### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such amount) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

#### Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) **Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Liens, And Judgment Lien Creditors.** — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lien, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

#### (b) Place For Filing Notice; Form. —

(i) **Place For Filing.** — The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed:

(A) **Under State Laws.**

(i) **Real Property.** — In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) **Personal Property.** — In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) **With Clerk Of District Court.** — In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State is not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A); or

(C) **With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia.** — In the office of the recorder of deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(ii) **This Of Property Subject To Lien.** — For purposes of paragraphs (i) and (ii), property shall be deemed to be situated:

- (A) **Real Property.** — In the case of real property, at the place of location, or
- (B) **Personal Property.** — In the case of personal property, wherever tangible or intangible, at the residence of the tax-payer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraphs (i) and (ii), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal conduct of business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(ii) **Form.** — The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

**Note:** See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

- 1. Securities
- 2. Motor vehicles
- 3. Personal property purchased or held
- 4. Personal property purchased or held as a trade or business
- 5. Personal property subjected to a consignment lien
- 6. Household articles and personal household items
- 7. Household articles and personal household items, and household articles and personal household items
- 8. Aircraft in air
- 9. Certain insurance premiums
- 10. Passports

#### (c) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section:

(i) **General Rule.** — Unless notice of lien is filed in the manner provided in paragraph (2) during the required refiling date, the notice of lien that is filed is valid for the period of time specified in accordance with subsection (d) after the expiration of the preceding period.

(ii) **Place For Filing.** — In one of the offices listed in the immediately preceding paragraph, in the manner:

- (A) **With Clerk Of District Court.** — In the office in which the notice of lien was filed, and
- (B) **In The Case Of Real Property.** — In the office of recording and securing in the title to the property referred to in subparagraph (A); and

- (C) **In Any Case In Which A Tax Lien Prima facie exists at the date of recording of notice of lien under subparagraph (A).** —

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the tax-payer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) **Required Refiling Period.** — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means —

- (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax; and
- (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

#### Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) **Release Of Lien.** — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which —

(i) **Bility Satisfied or Unenforceable.** — The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(ii) **Bond Accepted.** — There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

#### Sec. 6303. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(a) **Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.** —

(i) **Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien.** — If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
