AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING THE ESTABLISHMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Glenview has a population in excess of 40,400, as determined by the last official census and, accordingly, presuant to the provisions of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Ollinois, and particularly Article VII. Section 6(a) thereof, gald village is a home rule unit and as such may exercise any pover or function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the property owners in the Village of Glenview in an area commonly known as Eleanore's of Glenview have requested that the corporate authorities give consideration to the establishment of a Special Service Area in order to provide for the construction of a tourdation wail and fill in the unilted sidewalk, and

WHEREAS, the corporate anthorities, having given consideration to the proposal, deem it algorable to initiate precedings under the approable laws of the Scale of Illinois in connection with such proposal;

All interested persons including, but not limited to, all persons owning taxable real property affected by the formation of Glenview Special Service Area Number 27 will be given an opportunity to be heard regarding the formation of and the boundaries of the Special Service Area and may object to the formation of the Area, the issuance of bonds and the levy of taxes affecting said area.

Eleanore's of Glenview Special Service Area No. 27

The purpose of the formation of Glenview Special Service Area Number 27 in general is to provide special municipal services to the area, including the purchasing and all appurtenances thereto, the furnishing of all necessary labor and materials in connection therewith and any other similar types of amenities and improvements that shall be compatible with the proposed improved plan for the district.

The issuance of general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00 at an interest rate not to exceed ten and one-half (10.5) percent per annum and to mature within Twenty (20) years will be considered at the hearing; said bonds, if issued, shall be required by the levy of a direct tax to discharge the principal as it fatures and the interest thereon, said tax to be levied upon all taxable real property within the proposed Special Service Area.

At the hearing, all persons affected will be given an opportunity to be heard. The hearing may be adjourned by the Board to another date without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes of its meeting fixing the time and place of its adjournment.

If a petition signed by at least 51% of the electors residing within the Special Service Area and by at least 51% of the owners of record of the land included within the boundaries of the Special Service Area is filed with the municipal clerk within 60 days following the final adjournment of the Public Hearing objecting to the creation of the Special Service Area, the enlargement thereof, the levy or imposition of a tax or the issuance of bonds for the provision of special services to the area, or to proposed increase in the tax rate, no such district may be created or enlarged, or tax may be levied, or imposed nor the rate increased, or no such bonds may be issued.


