Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same alter comand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto). shall be a lien in Isyon of the United States upon all proporty, and rights to proporty, whense real or personal, bolonging to ouch person. Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless unother date is specifically fixed by lnw, the lien. imposed by addion 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the texpayer utiling out of such liability) is antisted or becomes unonforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Cértain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Liepors And Judgment Lien Creditors. ed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liener, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meats the require-ments of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(n) Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, In one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the tien is situtated; and
(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal
