

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 5321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand; the amount (including any interest, adaltional amount, addition to lax, or assessable penalty, together. with any costs that may accure in addition thereto) shall be a fien in tayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether feat or personal, belonging to such purson.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so seasod (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such flability) is astistied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security in-terests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judg-S ment Lien Creditors. - The iten imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as egainst any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until

## m Place For Fliing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (iii) shall be illed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Heal Property - In the case of roal property, in one effice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal proparty, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the Judicial district in which The property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

al subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia. In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the flen is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property; hether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpays that the time the notice of lien is filed, ...

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or part lersh to shall be deemed to be the place at which the princlosi excurre office of the business is located, and the realdence of a terprior whose residence is without the United States shall be or smed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3). Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be a ascribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid not what anding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of tien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this section

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of fian is rollled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the regulted reliting period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filing. - A notice of then refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(A)

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or. Discharge Of Property

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such requistions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall jesue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the dily on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanlorceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all intorest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has bijcome

legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the priyment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such it no), and that is in accordance with such requirements (all at arms, conditions, and form of the bend and sureties thereon as may be specified by such regulations.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. If a notice of lien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the immount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes salislactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such tien or intende to obtain a right in such property.
