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

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after domain, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together. with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a fien in lavor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 5321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out or such flability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323, Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by secilib 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until netice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the iten is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of ragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated .

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, was ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the texpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purrouns of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or part ters' in shall be deemed to be the place at which the princlost executive of the business is located, and the residence of a taxriiver whose residence is without the United States shall be diamed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The ir in and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid nomith as ting any other provision of law regarding the form or contest our notice of flen.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this section

- (1) General Rule.—Unless notice of lion is relified in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of tion shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (fi)) after the expiration of such reliting period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Of Discharge Of Property

(a) Release Of Lieft. — Subject to such regula-tions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the fieldity for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is lumished to the Secretary and compled by him a bond that is conditioned upon the psy or the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereo, with a time prescribed by law fincluding any adension a such lime), and that is in accordance with such require ments remaind to torms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies there a, as may be specified by such regulations.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lient-il a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be discissed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intende to obtain a right in such property.

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
