

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Codo

#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether read or personal, belonging to such person.

#### Sec. 6322 Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapso

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The fien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment flen creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

#### n Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Lews

(f) Neal Property - in the case of real property, in one effice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the fien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the pounty, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clark Of District Court-in the office of the cterk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to fien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Uen - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, when or tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation of partnership chall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive officer of the business is located, and the residence of a taxor or whose residence is without the United States shall be derived to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The for r and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwars and ag any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a lotice of lien.

**Note:** See section 6323(a) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

- 1. Securities
- 2. Motor vehicles
- 3. Personal property purchased at retail
- 4. Personal property purchased in casual sale
- 5. Personal property subjected to possessory lien
- 6. Real property tax and special assessment liens
- Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements
- 8. Altorney's liens
- 9. Certain insurance contracts

## (g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section.

- (1) **General Rule.**—Unless notice of tien is refuled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) Place For Filling, A notice of lien retiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only -

- (i) such notice of lien is reflect in the office in which the pair notice of lien was field, and
- (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
- (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lian under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the inflator prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such tion is also fired in accordance with subsection (f) in the Stille in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of tien, the serm "required refiling period" means

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of this tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years affer the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

### Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such spuletions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary that have a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secritary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all levest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and as wheel by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of he amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, with, the time prescribed by law (including my autiention of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements reculting to forms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon as may be specified by such regulations.

# Sec 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

#### (%) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien if it notice of lien has been filled pursuant to section 63/23(f), the amount of the outstanding obtigation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
