WHERLAS, Pursuant to Section 21(b)(4) of the Federal Home Loan Bank Act, as amended by Siction 501 of FIRREA, among other powers, the RTC as conservator may exercise any authority granted to the FDIC under Sections 11, 12, and 13 of the Federal Deposi' insurance Act as amended by Section 212, 213, 214, 216, and 217 of

WHEREAS, the RTC as conservator has determined that it is appropriate and necessary pursuant to Section 11(d)(2)(G) of the Federal Deposit Insurance Act, to transfer certain assets of the Association to St. Paul Federal Bank for Savings having its principal business in Chicago, Illinois.
