> AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE 91669470 -POR A DRIVE-THROUGH BANK PACILITY

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the Village of Arlington Heights, in petition number 91-007, pursuant to notice, has on September 25, 1991, conducted a public hearing on a request for a special use permit for a drive-through bank facility, located at 25 East Campbell Street, Arlington Heights, Illinois, which property is located in the B-5 Central Business District; and

SECTION ONE: That a special use permit 101

SECTION TWO: That the drive-through bank facility shall be constructed in compliance with all Village Codes and in substantial conformance with plans prepared by Griskelis + Smith Architects, Ltd., dated July 15, 1991 with revisions through October 14, 1991, consisting of three pages, a copy of which is on file with the Village Clerk and available for public inspection.

SECTION THREE: That the special use permit granted by SECTION ONE of this ordinance is conditioned upon compliance with the following requirements:

- The petitioner shall install landscape screening around the perimeter of the parking lot located on the southeast corner of Campbell Street and Evergreen Avenue, in accordance with the provisions of the Arlington Heights Municipal Code.
- 2. The relitioner shall restripe the parking lot located on the southeast corner of Campbell Street and Evergreen Avenue. The restriping shall include handicapped spaces in accordance with the handicap parking provisions of the Arlington Heights Municipal Code.

SECTION FOUR: The Village Clerk of the Village of Arlington Heights is hereby directed to file a copy of this ordinance in the Office of the Recorder of Cook County, Illinois.
