THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED JANUARY 10, 1991, between STANDARD BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, whose address is 240% WEST 95TH STREET, EVERGREEN PARK, IL 60642 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and SOUTHWEST FINANCIAL BANK AND TRUST, whose address is 9901 S. WESTERN AVENUE, CHICAGO, IL 60643 (referred to priow as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For visibable consideration, Grantor not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a deed or deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to Crantor pursuant to a Trust Agreement dated July 30, 1979 and known as STANDARD BANK AND TRUST U/T/A #6493, mortgages and conveys to Londer all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or infair d buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (in julying stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minorals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in COOK County, State of Illinois (the "Real Property"):

The North half of the North half of the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section 21, Township 36 North, Range 12, Last of the Third Principal Meridian, (excepting therefrom all that part thereof dedicated for public highways as per plat dated August 22, 1928 and recorded September 24, 1928 as document 10155683) in Cook County, Illinois.

The Real Property or Its address is commonly known as 165th Street and LaGrange Road, ORLAND PARK, IL 60462. The Real Propeny tax identification number is 27-21-403-002.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meaning: when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the Unifed States of America.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means STANDARD BANK AND TRUST COLIP NY, Trustee under that cortain Trust Agreement dated July 39, 1979 and known as STANDARD BANK AND TRUST U/T/A #6493. The Grantor is the prortigagor under this Mortgage.

Guarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation, eac!, and all of the guarantors, surelies, and accommodation parties in connection with the indebtedness.

Improvements. The word "Improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage.

Lender. The word "Lender" means SOUTHWEST FINANCIAL BANK AND TRUST, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the mortgage under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Granter and Lender, and includes without "mitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note or credit agreement dated January 10, 1991, In the command principal amount of \$285,000.00 from Grantor to Lender, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement. The interest rate on the Note is 10.750%.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, Interests and eights described above in the "Grant of Mongage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with Grantor's Indebtedness to Lander.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements and maintanance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. The terms "hazardous waste," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mortgago, shall have the same meanings as set forth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Pub. L. No. 99-499 ("SARA"), the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 8901, et seq., or other applicable state or Federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. Grantor represents

and warrants to Lender that: (a) During the period of Granton's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on, under, or about the Property.

(b) Grantor has no knowledge of, or reason to believe that there has been, except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (i) any use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by writing. (I) any use; generation, maintracture, storage, treament, disposar, release, or triteatened regase of any hazardous waste of substance by any prior owners or occupants of the Property or (II) any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any kind, by any person relating such matters. (c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing. (I) neither Grantor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other authorized user of the Property shall use, generate, manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or substance on, under, or about the Property and (ii) any such activity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state; and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Grantor authorizes Lender and regulations and ordinarces, including which initiation into a laws, regulations, and ordinarces above. Call the artistics compliance of the Property to make such inspections and lests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Montgage. Any inspections or lests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lender to Grantor or to any other person, The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Grantor's due difference in investigating the Property for hazardous waste. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Lender for indemnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims, losses, liablities, damages, penalties; and expenses which Lender may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer resulting from a breach of this section of the Mongage or as a consequence of any uso. generation, manufacture, storage, disposal, release or threatened release occurring prior to Grantor's ownership or interest in the Property, whether or not the same was or should have been known to Grantor. The provisions of this section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indemnify, shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the lien of this Mortgage and shall not be affected by Lender's acquisition of any interest in the Property, whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any prodon of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (no uding oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. As a confider to the removal of any improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace such improvements vith improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Entry. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to its root the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compilance with Governments' Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental aut ori's applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and with our compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's Interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither of plandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender hay, it its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, tit's o interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficia intract in or to any land trust holding little to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property Interest. It any Grantor is a correction or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by illinois faw.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment: Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to dally grency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material lurnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not rue, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Granter may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or cir in in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arise or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within filteen (15) days after the flori arises or, if a flori is filled, within litteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filling, secure the discharge of the flen, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond (1 oth in security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could a rue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgmen, hairse enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proctect or

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of vayment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statum ent of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction., Grantor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are turnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be as after on account of the work, services, or materials. Grantor will upon request of Lender turnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended co rerage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient of wold application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss of damage to the Property If the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$1,000.00. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor falls to do so within fitteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be paid to the principal balance of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor. be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Montgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Montgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Grantor's Report on Insurance. Upon request of Lender, however not more than once a year, Grantor shall furnish to Lender a report on each existing policy of insurance showing: (a) the name of the Insurer; (b) the risks Insured; (c) the amount of the policy; (d) the property insured, the then current replacement value of such property, and the manner of determining that value; and (e) the expiration date of the policy. Grantor shall, upon request of Lender, have an independent appraiser satisfactory to Lender determine the cash value replacement cost of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor falls to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or pold by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option; will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedies that it observes would have had from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

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Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, tree and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in any title Insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's little or the Interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAX. S, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Felia and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentar, the one, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall conclude taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by thir Mc (gage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which 'in' section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below in, and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Granter either. (a) pays the trix before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient verporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a securer, rights under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall or ocute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and continue Lender has Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, the executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a mariner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lender (s.c.n.d party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Compercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relaine to further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, fram or will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when required by Lender, cause to be filled, recorded, refilled, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Granter under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Docur and a first and prior liens on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Granter. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Granter shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expense.

Attorney-In-Fact. It Granter talls to do any of the things released to in the proceding paragraph, Lender may do so for and in the name of Granter and at Granter's expense. For such purposes, Granter hereby irrevocably appoints Lender as Granter's ultomoy-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will pay, if pointly by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage:

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or any other payment necessary to prevent filling of or to effect discharge of any lion.

Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Mortgage within the preceding twelve (12) months, it may be cured (and no Event of Default will have occurred) if Grantor, after Lender sends written notice demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within fifteen (15) days; or (b) if the cure requires more than fitteen (15) days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compilence as soon as reasonably practical.

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Londer by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, falso in any material respect.

Insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Illinois law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this Mortgage.

Foreclosure, etc. Commencement of foreclosure, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the indebtedness or such Guarantor dies or becomes incompetent. Lender, at its option, may, but shall not be required to, permit the Guarantor's estate to assume unconditionally the

Employment by Lender shall not disquality a person from facility as a receiver.

Deficiency Judgmer to permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of an amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after fallure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Len fer! right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender Institutes any sull or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the count may adjudge reasonable as atto...at a less at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's option are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limits ion, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-jurgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, and applicable law.
