

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code 5

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (Including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The Ean Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment flen creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(n Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection shall be lilled .

(A) Under State Laws

(i) "Real Property" in the case of real property, in one noffice within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and or

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or Intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

With Clark Of District Court in the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to tien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

Personal Property - In the case of personal property, ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpaye at the time the notice of lien is filed.

purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partr sish') shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive of the business is located, and the residence of a temp, or whose residence is without the United States shall be up imed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to In subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwins anding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of flen.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refilled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (i)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. -- A notice of then refiled during the required relilling period shall be effective only -

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the tempayer's residence, if a notice of such light is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located:

(3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of lian, the term frequired refiling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required retiling period for such notice of lien.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(e) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regula-tions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien Imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become logally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and a to pled by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respectthereo', within the time prescribed by law (including any extension o. such amp), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to some, conditions, and form of the bond and suretles thereou, to may be specified by such regulations.

> Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return-Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien.-If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lian may be disclosed to any person who lumishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
