MEMORANDUM OF LEASE

THIS MEMORANDUM OF LEASE is made this $\underline{4th}$ day of $\underline{January}$, by and between GRAND TRUNK WESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY, a Michigan 1991 corporation, having its office at 1333 Brewery Park Boulevard, Detroit, Michigan 48207-2699, hereinafter referred to as "Lessor", and TOWER COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS CORP., an Ohio corporation, having its office at 5000 Plaza on the Lake, Suite 100, Austin, Texas 78746, hereinafter referred to as "Lessee".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee entered into that certain Lease Agreement dated October 25, 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the "Lease Agreement") to a right-of-way for the installation, use and maintenance and operation therein of a telecommunications and transmission system on a portion of Lessor's railroad right-of-way, as more particularly described on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

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DESCRIPTION OF A PORTION OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE GRAND TRUNK WESTERN RAILROAD COMPANY CHICAGO, ILLINOIS TO PORT HURON, MICHIGAN ROUTE, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

A portion of the right-of-way of the Chicago, Illinois to Port Huron, Michigan route of the Grand Trunk Western Railroad Company lying within Cook County, Illinois. This segment hereinafter described begins at the junction of the Grand Trunk Western Chicago to Port Huron route with the Illinois Central Guir Railroad in the NEt of Section 17, T36N, R14E, in the City of Harvey and is more fully described as follows:
