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

#### Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cour

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, ind-ditional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; stall be a Sen in favor of the United States upon all properly and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the arrount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer ansing out of such bility) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of laptic of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The tien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Porsonal Property - In the case of personal prop erty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property

subject to the lien is situated, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to fien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia If the property subject to the lien is influented in the District of

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(2) Situs Of Property Bubject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deamed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical lucation; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property. whicher tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of Jen is fied.

For process of paragraph (2) (E), the residence of a corporation or partn, rishir, shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the restdence of a thrular at whose residence is without the United States shall be use med to be in the District of Columbia.

- (p) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of lien reflied during the required refiling period shall be effective only -

(A) #-

- (i) such notice of lien is raffled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
- (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an Index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

(3) Required Refiling Period. — in the case of any notice of ken, the term frequired refiling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the fax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling pence. for such notice of lien.

## Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- at Release Of Lien. Subject to such regula tions as the Scorctary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary linds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, annin the time prescribed by law (including any extenenlage tribula that is in accordance with such regulrements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties theteon, as they be specified by such regulations.
