- (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location or, if the property is a leasehold, at the residence of the taxpayer or, if the taxpayer is a corporation, at the residence of a shareholder or partner, or, if the taxpayer is a partnership, at the residence of a partner, or, if the taxpayer is a trust, at the residence of a trustee, or, if the taxpayer is an estate, at the residence of the executor or administrator, or, if the taxpayer is a decedent, at the residence of the decedent.
- (B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, at the residence of the taxpayer or, if the taxpayer is a corporation, at the residence of a shareholder or partner, or, if the taxpayer is a partnership, at the residence of a partner, or, if the taxpayer is a trust, at the residence of a trustee, or, if the taxpayer is an estate, at the residence of the executor or administrator, or, if the taxpayer is a decedent, at the residence of the decedent.
- (C) Property of a corporation - In the case of property of a corporation, at the residence of a shareholder or partner, or, if the taxpayer is a partnership, at the residence of a partner, or, if the taxpayer is a trust, at the residence of a trustee, or, if the taxpayer is an estate, at the residence of the executor or administrator, or, if the taxpayer is a decedent, at the residence of the decedent.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

3. Personal property purchased at auction
4. Personal property purchased in certain sale
5. Personal property subjected to post-mortem lien
6. Real property tax and special assessment liens
7. Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements

(c) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposes of this section -

(1) **General Rule.** - Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (b)) after the expiration of each refiling period.

(2) **Place For Filing.** - A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only -

- (A) if such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
- (B) in the case of real property, the fact of refiled is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (a) (4), and
- (C) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiled notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the
