THIS INDENTURE, made March 15 19 91, between

ROSEMARY DOHERTY

herein referred to as "Mortgagors," and CHICAGO TITLE AND TRUST COMPANY, an Illinois corporation doing business in Chicago, Illinois, herein referred to as TRUSTEE, witnesseth:

THAT, WHEREAS the Mortgagors are justly indebted to the legal holders of the Instalment Note hereinafter described, said legal holder or holders being herein referred to as Holders of the Note, in the principal sum of

--Ten Thousand and no/100-----

Dollars,

evidenced by one certain Instalment Note of the Mortgagors of even date herewith, made payable to THE ORDER OF BEARER

and delivered, in and by which said Note the Mortgagors promise to pay the said principal sum and interest from month to month on the balance of principal remaining from time to time unpaid at the rate of nine (9) percent per annum in instalments (including principal and interest) as follows:

---Two Hundred Seven and 59/100--- Dollars or more on the 1st day of May 19 91, and ---Two Hundred Seven and 59/100--- Dollars or more on the 1st day of each month thereafter until said note is fully paid except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the 1st day of April, 1996. All such payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by said note to be first applied to interest on the unpaid principal balance and the remainder to principal; provided that the principal of each instalment unless paid when due shall bear interest at the rate of -- per annum, and all of said principal and interest being made payable at such banking house or trust company in Chicago Illinois, as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of Richard F. Von Wahlde and Rosalie H. Von Wahlde

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagors to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained, by the Mortgagors to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents CONVEY and WARRANT unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate and all of their estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the Village of Oak Lawn COUNTY OF Cook AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

10538 Unit 1 S in Glenview Estates Condominium as delineated on a survey of the following described real estate: Lots 3 and 14 in Frank De Lugach's Central Avenue Gardens being a Subdivision of the East 1/5 of the East 1/2 of the North East 1/4 of Section 17, Township 37 North, Range 13 (except Streets and parts of streets heretofore dedicated) in Cook County, Illinois, which survey is attached as Exhibit "A" to the Declaration of Condominium recorded October 12, 1990, as Document 90500260, together with its undivided percentage interest in the common elements.

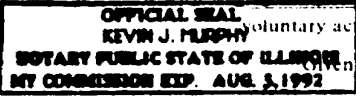
