

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Llenors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's flenor, or judgment tien creditor until notice thorsof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing • The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed •

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one coffice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the Sen is situated; and ISIC i

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one cifice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

With Clerk OI District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to tien its situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Deads of the District of Columbia, the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of mether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxwayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership that be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive of or of the business is located, and the restdence of a taxprin whose residence is without the United States shall be due ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The form and content of the notice referred to In subsection (a) shall be presembed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithst indir g any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a lieuce of lien.

(g) Refilling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of Ilen is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such retiting period,

(2) Place For Filing. - A notice of from retitled during the required retiling period shall be effective only .

(i) such notice of lien is relited in the office in which

the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) In the case of real property, the last of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (I) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

(3) Required Refilling Reriod, -in the case of any notice of tien, the term "required refilling period" means -(A) the one-year paried ending 30 days after the expiration

of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the fax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regula-tions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any fien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all inlerest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

Mostly unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is lumished to the Secretary and are up and by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment on the amount assessed, logether with all interest in respect thereof, within he time prescribed by law (including any extenequiper visua with the accordance with such require ments relaung to times, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

> Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes:-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any person who lumishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such tien or intends to obtain a right in such property.



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
