

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cods

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether rest or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec.-6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the fien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unaniorceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (1) has been filed by the Secretary.

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property aubject to the lien is shuated; or

With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the Judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subcomporably (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

Columbia.

(2) Shus Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of the 3rd paragraphs (1) and (4), properly shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(5) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the tax-

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partner hip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive unifice of the business is located, and the restdence of a texpriser whose residence is without the United States shall be dearned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall it a pre-cribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwith tanking any other provision of law

regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(p) Reflling Of Notice. - For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of lien is refried in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the regulted refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of tion refiled during the required reliting period shall be effective only

(i) such notice of tien is relified in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of reliting is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiting of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Sucretary received written information (in the mariner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, it a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State In which such residence is located, :

(3) Required Refiling Period,—In the case of any notice of lien, the tarm 'required reliling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the fax, and (8) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required reliking period for such notice of lien. 300

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leave a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

jagatly unenforceable; or

(2) Bird Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amplint assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, which the time prescribed by law (including any extension of ruch tin e), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to commis, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, a may be specified by such regulations.

> Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosur + of-Returns and Return information.

(x) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes:-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who lumishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
