Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person limite to pay any lax neglects or refuses to pay the same after donesal, the amount finducing any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty (opether with any coats that may accrue in addition thoroto) shall be a iten in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the flen Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment then creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

n Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other povernmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property aubject to

the lien is situtated; and

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated-(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical incation; or

(B) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the tine the notice of lies is filed.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or par nerr tip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal elecuive office of the business is located, and the residence of a trupaver whose residence is without the United States shall be or amed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The frim and content of the notice referred to In subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwith tax time any other provision of law regarding the form or contest of a notice of tien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this

(1) General Rule.—Unless notice of tien is relijed in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refilling period.

12) Place For Filing .-- A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only-

(A) If-

(i) such notice of then is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of ilen was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of retiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of fien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lies is also filed in accordance with aubsection (f) in the State in which such residence is

(3) Required Refilling Period.—In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required rollling penod" means-

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 1D years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such natice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien .- Subject to such reputations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a cardicate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Satisfied of Unenforcestile - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount essetsed, togethor with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Seof the ry and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon psyment of the amount assessed, together with all interset In rear of the real, within the time prescribed by law (including any at tenalo , of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirement of relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and rundles thereon, as may be specified by such

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(N) Disclosure of Certain Fleturns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of tien has been filled pursuant to section 4325(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any parson who furnishes natisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property aubject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
