

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after definable, the amount including any interest, additional amount addition for tax, on speciable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in fayor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the iten imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the anoths so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien Imposed by Section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment flen creditor until notice theroof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

(n) Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in sub-section (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situitated; and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental-subdivision), as designated by the tews of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State taw merely conforming to reenacting Federal law estantishing a national filting system does not constitute a second office for 19thing as designated by the laws of such State; or 18th With Clerk Of District Countin the pilice of the

(B) With Clerk Of District Countin the office of the clerk of the United States district count for the judicial district in which the property subject to then is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Colimbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District
of Columbia, if the property subject to the item is situated in the
District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated-(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(B) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tannible or intangiple, at the residence of the taxpayer at the titus the notice of tien is filled.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or par ners tip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal effective office of the business is located, and the residence of the payer whose residence is without the United States shall be diemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The fr.m. and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shift be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwith all noting any other provision of law regarding the form or cont. of fire notice of lien.

(g) Refilling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section-

(1) General Rule.—Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filing.—A notice of iten refited during the required refiling period shall be effective only-

(A) if-

(i) such action of tien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of tien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (i) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the "Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a nucleo of such lien is size that in accordance with subsection (i) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. —In the case of any notice of ilen, the term "required refiling period" means.

(A) the one-year period ending 50 days witer the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(B) the con-year period ending with the expitation of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lian.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Reletise Of Lien.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a cartificate of release of any flan imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforcechie - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with -fill interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Serviciary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the part of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect to ered, within the time prescribed by law (included any latent on of such time), and that is in accordance with such required and straight to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suration thereon, as may be specified by such

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(k) Disciosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6325(I), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
