III. NOTIFICATION

Under the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 2 owners of real property may be held liable for costs related to the release of hazardous substances.

1. Section 22.2(f) of the Act3 states:

"Motwithstanding any other provision (or rule) of law, and subject only to the defenses set forth in subsection (j) of this Section, the following persons shall be liable for all costs of removal or remedial action incurred by the State of Illinois as a result of a release or substantial threat of a release of a hazardous substance:

- (1) The owner and operator of a facility or vessel from which there is a release of substantial threat of release of a hazardous substance;
- (2) Any person who at the time of disposal, transport, storage or treatment of a hazardous substance owned or operated the facility or vessel used for such disposal, transport, treatment or storage from which there was a release or substantial threat of a release of any such hazardous substance:
- (3) Any person who by contract, agreement, or otherwise has arranged with another party or entity for transport, storage, disposal or treatment of hazardous substances owned, controlled or possessed by such person at a facility there is a release or substantial threat of a release of such hazardous substantial; and
- (4) Any person who accepts or accepted any hazardous substances for transport to disposal, atdrage or treatment facilities or sites from which there is a release or a subgrantial threat of a release of a hazardous substance."
- 2. Section 4(q) of the Act states:

"The Agency shall have the cuthority to provide notice to any person who may be liable pursuant to Section 27.2(f) of this Act for a release or a substantial threat of a release of a hazardous substance. Such notice shall include the identified response action and in opportunity for such person to perform the response action."

]. Section 22.2(k) of the Act states:

"If any person who is liable for a release of substantial threat of release of a hazardous substance fails without sufficient cause to provide removal or remedial action upon or in accordance with a notice and request by the agency ipon or in accordance with any order of the Board of any court, such person may be liable to the State for punitive damages in an amount at least equal to, and not more than 3 times, the amount of any costs incurred by the State of Illinois as result of such failure to take such removal of remedial action. The punitive damage imposed by the Board shall be in addition to any costs recovered from such person pursuant to this Section and in addition to any other penalty or relief provided by this Act or any other law."

4. Jection 22.19(a) of the Act 5 states:

"Notwithstanding any other provision or rule or law, except as provided otherwise in subsection (b), the owner or operator, or both, of an underground storage tank shall be liable for all costs of preventive action, corrective action and enforcement action incurred by the State of Illinois as a result of a release or a substantial threat of release of petroleum from an underground storage tank."

5. The text of the statutes set out above is subject to change by amendment. Persons using this form may update it to reflect changes in the text of the statutes cited, but no disclosure statement shall be invalid merely because it sets forth an obsolete or superseded version of such test.
