COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS:

1. In case of default therein, Mortgages may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgagors in ary form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromist or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee in its discretion to protect the premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of 15.5 per cent per annum. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagors.
- 5. Mortgagee making any payment hereby authorized relating to tax's or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate produced from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement a estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or ritle or claim thereof.
- 6. At the option of the Mortgagee and without demand upon or notice to Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the Note or in this Mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable when default shall occur, and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors, herein contained.
- 7. In the event that Mortgagors or either of them (a) consent to the appointment of a receiver, trustee, or liquidator of all or a substantial part of Mortgagors' assets, or (b) be adjudicated a bankrupt or insolvent, or file a voluntary petition in bankruptcy, or admit in writing their inability to pay debts as they become due, or (c) make a general assignment for the benefit of creditors, or (d) file a petition or answer seeking reorganization or arrangement with creditors, or to take advantage of any insolvency law, or (e) file an answer admitting the material allegations of a petition filed against Mortgagors in any bankruptcy, reorganization, or insolvency proceeding, or (f) take any

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action for the purpose of effecting any of the foregoing, or (g) any order, judgment or decree shall be entered upon an application of a creditor of the Mortgagors by a court of competent jurisdiction approving a petition seeking appointment of a receiver or trustee of all or a substantial part of the Mortgagors' assets and such order, judgment or decree shall continue unstayed and in effect for any period of 30 consecutive days, the holder of the Note may declare the Note forthwith due and payable, whereupon the principal and interest accrued on the Note and all other sums hereby secured, shall become forthwith due and payable is if all of the said sums of money were originally stipulated to be paid on such date; and thereupon the Mortgagee without notice or demand, may prosecute a suit at law and/or in equity as if all money secured hereby had matured prior to its institution. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed a such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a dericiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, is well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection (including insurance and repairs), possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period.
