

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person hable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to hable same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penety-together with any costs that may access in addition theretgy shall be a tien in favor of the United States upon all property and Light's to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such personal, re-

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by taw, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the sessement is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The iten imposed by Sertion 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien preditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.
