1. The first step is to identify the problem or question that needs to be answered. This involves understanding the context and the specific information required.

1. *Staphylococcus aureus* (ATCC 12228) was grown in tryptic soy broth (TSB) (Difco) supplemented with 0.5% yeast extract (Difco) and 0.5% glucose (Difco) at 37°C. Cells were harvested at mid-log phase (OD<sub>600</sub> = 0.5) and washed with phosphate buffered saline (PBS) (pH 7.4) containing 100 μg/ml penicillin, 100 μg/ml streptomycin, and 100 μg/ml nystatin.
