MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATE APRIL 29, 1991, between HARRIS BANK BARRINGTON, N.A., AN ILLINOIS CORPORATION, whose address is 201 S. GROVE, BARRINGTON, IL (referred to below as "Granfor"); and LARKIN BANK, whose address is 2555 W. GOLF ROAD, HOFFMAN ESTATES, IL 60194 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mongage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mongage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful

Borrower. The word "Borrower" means INVERNESS DEVELOPMENT, INC...

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means HARRIS BANK BARRINGTON, N.A., Trustee under that certain Trust Agreement dated September 13, 1989 and known as HARRIS BANK BARRINGTON, N.A.* The Grantor is the mongagor under this Mongage. * 10... 11-1288

Guarantor. The wort' Guarantor' means and includes without limitation, each and all of the guarantors, sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the Industrial directs.

Improvements. The word "morovements" means and includes without familiation all existing and future improvements, factores, buildings, structures, mobile homes after don the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebted" ass' means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Sirinfor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Morigage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Morigage.

Leader. The word "Leader" means LARIQ (PAN), its successors and assigns. The Leader is the mortgages under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note or credit agreement dated April 29, 1991, in the original principal amount of \$425,000.00 from Borrower to Lender, together with all entereds of, excessions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement. The articlest rate on the Note is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 9.000% per annum. The interest rate to be applied to the impaid principal balance of this Mortgage shall be at a rate of 2.000 percentage point(s) over the Index, subject however to the folk sing minimum and maximum rates, resulting in an initial rate of 11.000% per annum. NOTICE: Under no circumstances shall the interest rate on this Mortgage be less than 8.500% per annum or more than (except for any higher default rate shown below) the lesser of 18.000% per annum or the maximum rate allowed by applicable law. NOTICE TO GRANTOR: THE NOTE CONTAINS A VARIABLE INTEREST RATE.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixure it, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Gramor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; togeth and the all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds first using without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation of promissory notes, credit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with Borrower's Indebtedness to Lender.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future tents, revenues, income, issues, royalities, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND TERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDESTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF CHARTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TURNS:

GRANTOR'S WAIVERS. Grantor waives all rights or delenses arising by reason of any "one action" or "anti-deliciency" law, or any other law which may prevent Lender from bringing any action against Grantor, including a claim for deliciency to the extent Lender is otherwise emitted to a claim for deliciency, before or after Lender's commencement or completion of any foreclosure action, either judicially or by exercise of a power of sale.

GRANTOR'S REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES. Grantor warrants that: (a) this Morigage is executed at Somewe's request and not at the request of Lander; (b) Grantor has the full power and right to enter into this Morigage and to hypothecate the Property; (c) Grantor has established adequate means of obtaining from Borrower on a continuing basis information about Borrower's financial condition; and (d) Lender has made no representation to Grantor about Borrower (including without limitation the creditworthiness of Borrower).

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mongage, Sonower shall pay to Lender all Indebtedness secured by this Mongage as it becomes due, and Sonower and Grantor shall strictly perform all their respective obligations under this Mongage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Gramor and Borrower agree that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rems from the Property.

Outy to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. The terms "hazardous waste," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mortgage, shall have the same meanings as set torth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superband Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Pub. L. No. 99-499 ("SARA"), the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 49 U.S.C.

Section 6901, et seq., or other applicable state or Federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. Grantor represents and warrants to Lender that: (a) During the period of Grantor's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on, under, or about the Property. (b) Grantor has no knowledge of, or reason to believe that there has been, except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (7) any use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any prior owners or occupants of the Property or (ii) any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any land by any person relating to such matters. (c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (i) neither Grantor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other authorized user of the Property shall use, generate, manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or substance on, under, or about the Property and (ii) any such activity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable lederal, state, and local laws. regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Granlor authorizes Lender and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Montgage. Any inspections or tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lender to Granior or to any other person. The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Grantor's due diligence in investigating the Property for hazardous waste. Grantor horeby (a) releases and waives any lature claims against Lender for indemnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnity and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, and expenses which Lender may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer resulting from a breach of this section of the Mongage or as a consequence of any use, generation, manufulative, storage, disposal, release or threatened release occurring prior to Grantor's ownership or interest in the Property. whether or not the same was or should have been known to Grantor. The provisions of this section of the Mongage, including the obligation to indemnify, shall survive in payment of the Indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the lien of this Montgage and shall not be affected by Lender's activities of any interest in the Property, whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

hulsance, Waste. Grantor clust not cause, conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gar), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Londer to replace such improvements with improvements of 1999 and value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and as agentr and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property for L'urposes of Grantor's compliance with the forms and conditions of this Moragage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Gram's shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or herealter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the rise or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lender's interests in the Purperty are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to project Lunder's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unatte ide! the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

OUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Empery, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether is just or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary, whether by outright sale, deed, instalkment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust h king, the to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or partnership, transfer is includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by Jederal law or by Illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and tiens on the Property are a part of his Mongage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, as ecial taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all dains it is work done on or for services rendered or material lumished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all tiens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mongage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provider in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any lax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith ('sp tie over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not isopardized. If a lien arises or is filled as a result of nonpayment, C, a for shall within filleen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filled, within filleen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filling, secure the Circharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' lees or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foredoxure or sale under the lien. In any comest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an attitional obligee under any surely bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least filtren (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials. Grantor will upon request of Lender lumish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mongage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property.

apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal balance of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in tuil of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foredosine sale of such Property.

Grantor's Report on Insurance. Upon request of Lender, however not more than once a year, Grantor shall furnish to Lender a report on each existing policy of insurance showing: (a) the name of the insurer; (b) the risks insured; (c) the amount of the policy; (d) the properly insured, the then current replacement value of such properly, and the manner of determining that value; and (e) the expiration date of the policy. Grantor shall upon request of Lender, have an independent appraiser satisfactory to Lender determine the cash value replacement cost of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property. Lender on Grantor's behalf snay, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of recognition. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand. (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either. (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining ferm of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's materity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise which have had.

WARRANTY: DEFENSE OF TITLE. The Woming provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Granter warrants that: (a) Granter holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all fiens and encumbrances other than those set with in the Real Property description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in lavor of, and accepted by, Lender in commiction with this Mortgage, and (b) Granter has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the partigraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action of proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Grantor will definer, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender a sy request from time to time to participation.

Compliance With Laws. Granior warrants that the Property and Cranior's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION. The lollowing provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Morigage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemited by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in fieu of condemnation, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall my an the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and alterneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lend'ar in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the priminal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of the own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:
