in addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

A. USE OF PROPERTY; COMPLIANCE WITH LAW.

Borrower shall not seek, agree to or make a change in the use of the Property or its zoning classification, unless Lender has agreed in writing to the change. Borrower shall comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations and requirements of any governmental body applicable to the Property.

B. SUBOADINATE LIENS.

Except as permittive by federal law, Borrower shall not allow any lien inferior to the Security Instrument to be perfected against the Property without Lender's prior written permission.

C. RENT LOSS INSURANCE.

Borrower shall maintain it au ance against rent loss in addition to the other hazards for which insurance is required by Uniform Covenant 5.

D. "BORROWER'S RIGHT" TO REINSTATE" DELETED.

Uniform Covenant 18 is deleted.

E. ASSIGNMENT OF LEASES.

Upon Lender's request, Borrower shall assign to Lender all leases of the Property and all security deposits made in connection with leases of the Property. Upon the assignment, Len fer shall have the right to modify, extend or terminate the existing leases and to execute new leases, in Lender's sole discretion. As used in in's paragraph E, the word "lease" shall mean "sublease" if the Security Instrument is on a leasehold.

F. ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS.

Borrower unconditionally assigns and transfers to Lender all the rents and revenues of the Property. Borrower has not executed any prior assignment of the rents and has not and will not perform any act that would prevent Lender from exercising its rights under this Paragraph F.

Lender shall not be required to enter upon, take control of or maintain the Property perod or after giving notice of breach to Borrower. However, Lender or a judicially appointed receiver may do so at any time there is a bread. Any application of rents shall not cure or waive any default or invalidate any other right or remedy of Lender. This assignment of rents of the Property shall terminate when the debt secured by the Security Instrument is paid in full.

G. CROSS-DEFAULT PROVISION.

Borrower's default or breach under any note or agreement in which Lender has an interest shall be a pract under the Security in strument and Lender may invoke any of the remedies permitted by the Security Instrument.
