

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

#### Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or incluses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assectable penalty, together with any costs that may accrus in adducts, hereto; shall be a lien in fever of the Linited States upon all impactly and rights to properly, whether real or personal, befor ging to such person.

#### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such Rability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reseon of lapse of itms.

# Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien Imposed by section 6321 shell not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

### m Place For Filing Notice; Form .-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice released to in cubeaction (s) shall be filed-(A) Under State Laws (I) Real Property - In the case of real property, in

one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the ews of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situtated: and

(II) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (on the county, or other governmental within the pass (of the bound, or other governments subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, its which the property subject to the lien is eliusted; except that State law merely conforming to respecting Federal law establishing a national filing

system does not constitute a second office for Illing es dealgrased by the lawe of such State; or (8) With Clark Of District Court-in the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district

(2) Situa Ot Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), properly shall be deemed to be situated-(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(B) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of iten is filled.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or permeranip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia,

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law anding the form or content of a notice of lian.

(g) Refilling Of Notice.—For his cases of this
