

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, addrional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tion in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien inposed by section 8321 shall arise at the timo the assessment is made and chall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the texpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The tien imposed by soction 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

in Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), an designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the Ren is attuated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal proparty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the here is altuated; or

(B) With Clark Of District Count-In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. if the property aubject to the ken is situated in the District of Columbia.

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(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property. chedicy tanging or intangible, at the residence of the tax-

payer at the time the notice of lien is filed. For purprises of caragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership that be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive of or of the business is located, and the residence of a taxory - whose residence is without the United States shall be accorded to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to

in subsection (a) shall us prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithst undtrig any other provision of law regarding the form or content up a lotice of fien.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) duting the required refiling period such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed in accordance with subsection (fi) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filling. A notice of tien relified during the required refiling period shall be effective only -
 - A: A.
 - (i) such notice of fem is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
 - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refring of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Becretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpeyor's residence, it is notice of such her is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the Stale in which such residence is localed.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — to the same of any notice of use, the term "required refung period" means - (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration

of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the fax, and (D) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 3 years after the close of the preceding required reliling period for such notice of lien.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a pertificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully selected or has become

legaliy unentorceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and ancing ad by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment or the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, Athin he time prescribed by less (including any entension of s. on P. (e), and that is in accordance with such requirements relaurip to 11 mis, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

> Sec. \$103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

- a) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes .-
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding iten, if a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to each lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
