This Mortgage is dated as of May 15, 1991, and is between GUS PAPPAS, NOW MARRIED TO ELENI M. PAPPAS and NBD Park Ridge Bank, Park Ridge, Illinois ("Mortgagee").

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Witnesseth:

Mortgagor has executed a Revolving Credit Note dated the same date as this Mortgage payable to the order of Mortgagee (the "Note") in the principal amount of \$23,000.00 (the "Line of Credit"). Interest on the Note shall be calculated on the daily unpaid principal balance of the Note at the per annum rate equal to one (1.00%) percent per annum in excess of the Variable Rate Index.

Mortgagor promises to repay all amounts of principal and interest on the Note. On or before the payment date shown on the Mortgagor's monthly account statement, the Mortgagor shall pay to the Bank the amount due in accordance with the payment option selected below:

- Monthly payment equal to the accrued interest on the Note.
Monthly payments equal to one sixtieth (1/60th) of the principal balance outstanding on the Note or \$100.00, whichever is greater.

The entire unpaid balance of principal and interests on the Note, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on May 21, 1996.

To secure payment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note and the Liabilities (defined below), including any and all renewals and extensions of the Note, Mortgagor does by these presents Convey, Warrant and Mortgage unto Mortgagee, all of Mortgagor's estate, right, title and interest in the real estate situated, lying and being in the County of Cook and State of Illinois, legally described as follows:

Parcel 1:

The South 40 feet of lot 2 in Penny and Roots Subdivision of block 6 in Penny and Meachams Subdivision of the South East quarter of Section 26, Township 41 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian also

Parcel 2:

That part of lot 2 in Penny and Roots Subdivision of block 6 in Penny and Meachams Subdivision of the South East quarter of Section 26, Township 41 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian; bounded and described as follows: Commencing at a point on the West line of said lot 2, 60 feet South of the North West corner thereof, and running thence North along said West line a distance of 6 feet; thence South Easterly in a straight line to a point in the East line of said lot 2 which is 60 feet South of the North East corner of said lot 2 and running thence West along a line parallel to and 60 feet South of the North line of said lot 2 to the place of beginning, all in Cook County, Illinois.

which is referred to herein as the "Premises", together with all improvements, buildings, hereditaments, appurtenances, gas, oil, minerals, easements located in, on or over or under the Premises, and all types and kinds of fixtures, including without limitation, all of the foregoing used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration or ventilation (whether single units or centrally controlled) and all screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, awnings, stoves and water heaters, whether now on or in the Premises or hereafter erected, installed or placed on or in the Premises. The foregoing items are and shall be deemed a part of the Premises and a portion of the security for the Liabilities.

The Note evidences a "revolving credit" as defined in Illinois Revised Statutes Chapter 17, Paragraph 6405. The lien of this Mortgage secures payment of any existing indebtedness and future advances made pursuant to the Note, to the same extent as if such future advances were made on the date of the execution of this Mortgage, without regard to whether or not there is any advance made at the time this Mortgage is executed and without regard to whether or not there is any indebtedness outstanding at the time any advance is made.

Further, Mortgagor does hereby pledge and assign to Mortgagee, all leases, written or verbal, rents, issues, and profits of the Premises, including without limitation, all rents, issues, profits, revenues, royalties, bonuses, rights and benefits due, payable or accruing, and all deposits of money as advance rent or for security, under any and all present and future leases of the Premises, together with the right, but not the obligation, to collect, receive, demand, sue for and recover the same when due or payable. Mortgagee by acceptance of this Mortgage agrees, as a personal covenant applicable to Mortgagor only, and not as a limitation or condition hereof and not available to anyone other than Mortgagor, that until a Default shall occur or an event shall occur, which under the terms hereof shall give to Mortgagee the right to foreclose this Mortgage, Mortgagor may collect, receive and enjoy such avails.

Further, Mortgagor does hereby expressly waive and release all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois.

Further, Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any building or improvements now or hereafter on the Premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep the Premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and, except for this Mortgage, free from any encumbrances, except for prior Mortgages which have been disclosed to Mortgagee; security interests, liens, mechanics' liens or claims for lien; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the Premises, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such lien or charge to Mortgagee; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of construction upon the Premises; (e) comply with all requirements of all laws or municipal ordinances with respect to the Premises and the use of the Premises; (f) make no material alterations in the Premises, except as required by law or municipal ordinance, unless such alterations have been previously approved in writing by Mortgagee; (g) refrain from impairing or diminishing the value of the Premises.
2. Mortgagor shall pay, when due and before any penalty attaches, all general taxes, special taxes, special assessments, water taxes, assessments or charges against the Premises. Mortgagor shall, upon written request, furnish to Mortgagee duplicate paid receipts for such taxes, assessments and charges. To prevent Default hereunder

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of the Premises. The term "Default" as used in this Mortgage shall mean the failure of the Mortgagor to pay the Note or to perform any other obligation under the Note...

14. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Mortgage, the court in which such suit is filed may appoint a receiver of the Premises. The receiver's appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of the Mortgagor at the time of application for the receiver and without regard to the value of the Premises or whether the Premises shall be then occupied as a homestead or not.

13. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: first, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all the items that are mentioned in the immediately preceding paragraph; second, in full satisfaction of the debt secured by this Mortgage and interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note and the Liabilities (first to the Mortgagor, then to the heirs, legal representatives, successors or assigns, as their rights may appear).

12. When the indebtedness secured hereby shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, the Mortgagor shall have the right to foreclose the lien of this Mortgage. In any suit to foreclose the lien of this Mortgage, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the judgment of foreclosure all expenditures and expenses which have been paid or incurred by or on behalf of the Mortgagor for attorneys' and stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs of procuring all Torrens certificates, tax lien searches and examinations, title insurance policies and abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, tax lien searches, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem to be reasonably necessary.

11. "Liabilities" means any and all liabilities, obligations and indebtedness of the Mortgagor or any other maker of the Note to Mortgagee for payment of any and all amounts due under the Note or this Mortgage, whether herebefore, now owing or hereafter arising or owing, due or payable, howsoever created, arising or evidenced hereunder or under the Note, whether direct or indirect, absolute or contingent, primary or secondary, joint or several, whether existing or arising, together with attorneys' and paralegals' fees relating to the Mortgagor's rights, remedies and security interests hereunder, including advising the Mortgagor of drilling any documents for the Mortgagee at any time.

10. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Mortgage, no sale, lease, mortgage, trust deed, grant by Mortgagee or an encumbrance of any kind, conveyance, transfer of occupancy or possession, contract to sell, or transfer of the Premises, or any part thereof, or sale or transfer of ownership of any beneficial interest or power of direction in a land trust which holds title to the Premises, shall be made without the prior written consent of Mortgagee.

9. Upon the request of Mortgagee, Mortgagee shall deliver to Mortgagee all original leases of all or any portion of the Premises, together with assignments of such leases from Mortgagee to Mortgagee, which assignments shall be in form and substance satisfactory to Mortgagee; Mortgagee shall not, without Mortgagee's prior written consent, procure, permit or accept any prepayments, discharge or compromise of any rent or release any tenant from any obligation, at any time while the indebtedness secured hereby remains unpaid.

8. If Mortgagee makes any payment authorized by this Mortgage relating to taxes, assessments, charges, liens, security interests or encumbrances, received from the appropriate party claiming such funds without inquiry into the accuracy or validity of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of the lien, encumbrance, security interest, tax assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

7. Mortgagee shall keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on the Premises insured against loss or damage by flood, if the Premises is located in a flood hazard zone. Each insurance policy shall be for an amount sufficient to pay in full the cost of replacing or repairing the buildings and improvements on the Premises and, in no event less than the principal amount of the Note. Mortgagee shall obtain liability insurance with respect to the Premises in an amount which is acceptable to Mortgagee. All policies shall be issued by companies satisfactory to Mortgagee. Each insurance policy shall name Mortgagee as an "additional insured" and be payable, in case of loss or damage, to Mortgagee. Each insurance policy shall contain a lender's loss payable clause or endorsement, in form and substance satisfactory to Mortgagee. Mortgagee shall deliver to Mortgagee insurance policies, including additional and renewal policies, to insure the Premises, including all buildings and improvements, against fire, lightning, windstorm, vandalism and malicious damage and such other hazards as may from time to time be designated by Mortgagee.

5. No remedy or right of Mortgagee hereunder shall be exclusive. Each right or remedy of Mortgagee with respect to the Liabilities, this Mortgage or the Premises shall be in addition to every other remedy or right now or hereafter existing at law or in equity. No delay by Mortgagee in exercising, or omitting to exercise, any remedy or right accruing on Default shall impair any such remedy or right, or shall be construed to be a waiver of any such Default, or acquiescence therein, or shall affect any subsequent Default of the same or different nature. Every such remedy or right may be exercised concurrently or independently, and when and as often as may be deemed expedient by Mortgagee.

4. Any award of damages resulting from condemnation proceedings, exercise of the power of eminent domain, or the taking of the Premises for public use is hereby transferred, assigned and shall be paid to Mortgagee; and such awards or any part thereof may be applied by Mortgagee, after the payment of all of Mortgagee's expenses, including costs and attorneys' and paralegals' fees, to the reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby and Mortgagee is hereby authorized, on behalf and in the name of Mortgagee, to execute and deliver valid acquittance and to appeal from any such award.

3. Upon the request of Mortgagee, Mortgagee shall deliver to Mortgagee all original leases of all or any portion of the Premises, together with assignments of such leases from Mortgagee to Mortgagee, which assignments shall be in form and substance satisfactory to Mortgagee; Mortgagee shall not, without Mortgagee's prior written consent, procure, permit or accept any prepayments, discharge or compromise of any rent or release any tenant from any obligation, at any time while the indebtedness secured hereby remains unpaid.
