

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Gode

## Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person hedis to pay any tax neglects or refuses to be, the same after demand, the amount including any interest additional amount, and time to tax for accessable principle together with any crisis that may accrue in addition ments, shall be a licen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law the iten imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the time by the manual so assessed (or a judgment against the raippayer arising out of such lability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by mason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mischanic's leaves or judgement lien creditor until notice thereof which maghing counterments of subsection (It has been filed by the Secretary

## m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in sub-section (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Roal Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lian is situated, and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is altituated; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national fitting system does not constitute a second office for filling as designated by the taws of such State; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the derk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to iten is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia. paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated-(A. (g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section-

(1) General Rule.—Unless notice of tien a reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refling period, auch notice of tien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filling.—A notice of lien ratiled during the required ratiling period shall be effective only-

(A) If-

 ii) such notice of iten is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(a) in the case of real property, and the fact of refling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received witten information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concorning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such ten is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of tion, the term "required refiling period" means:

(A) the one-year period ending 35 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the lax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required reftling period for such notice of tilen.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien, — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any filen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with ell interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by nim a bond Set 's conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all insrest ir respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requir ments relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond an america thereon, as may be specified by such requisitions.

Sec. 6193 Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(a) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Discipsure of amount of outstanding filen, if a notified of iten has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such ten may be discipsed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that ne has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
